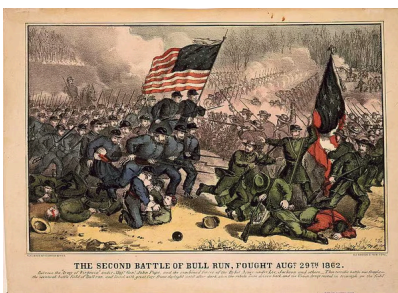

We are celebrating **Library Card Sign Up Week** by hosting this drop in event through which new patrons can pop in and sign up for a FREE library card. Access to a library card means you can check out materials from the library but also access online materials. Library cards are 100% free and only require a bit of information (name, address, phone, signatures, etc.). If you are a young person and want your own library card, you just need to get a parent signature.

We will also host a self-guided event, Heritage Stories, through which we are celebrating Libraries Remember Week. This event will include the opportunity to explore several historical items and documents pertaining to the history of Victor, the county, and of course the library.

Both of these events will occur during open library hours (M, W, F from 9am-6pm and Saturday from 9am-3pm) the week of September 8-13.
