- Clay: 1-2 bags of Highfire cone 10 Clay (25 lbs) I recommend Dillo White
- Pottery tools such as the tool kit from Kemper. (Necessary tools are a sponge, potter's wood knife, a needle tool, trimming tools and a cutting wire.)
- Fettling knife F96
- serrated rib
- 1 hand towel
- Sharpie
- Sketch book
- Wood ruler
- 2 quart bucket with lid
