



Community Build Installation Equipment & Tools

Here is the list of tools that we can never have too many on site...

- Tape Measures – 25' (a variety of lengths are used/needed)
- Levels – 4' levels, 2' levels, torpedo levels (longer levels can be useful)
- Ladders – step ladders are the most useful
- Ratchets – $\frac{3}{8}$ " drive (everybody should be armed with a $\frac{3}{8}$ " drive ratchet)
- Wrenches – $\frac{9}{16}$ " (everybody should be armed with a $\frac{9}{16}$ " wrench)
- Other wrenches – $\frac{1}{2}$ ", $\frac{3}{4}$ " and $\frac{5}{8}$ " are also used (occasionally needed)
- Drills (the ubiquitous rechargeable kind) – and a cordless impact driver
- Utility Knives – for cutting packaging and trimming TenderTuff
- Dead Blow Hammer – for gentle persuasion (without damaging equipment)

For digging, adjusting & cleaning out holes

- Steel Digging Bars
- Shovels (spade)
- Post hole digger (hand)
- Soil tamper
- Wheelbarrows (used for concrete too)

Other Tools: Every play structure is different, and while on most structures we utilize our Landscape Structures consistent-sized hardware (for example; 90% of what we'll use involves our T45 torques head cap screw and a $\frac{9}{16}$ " nut), some elements will need a not-as-frequently used tool. So, having a socket set, a wrench set, and an allen wrench set on hand is always beneficial.
