

Subject: Please Protect My Right to Vote – Vote NO on the “Save America Act”

Dear Senator [Last Name],

I am your constituent, a U.S. citizen living abroad and voting in [State], and I am asking you in the strongest possible terms to protect my right to vote by voting NO on the so-called “Save America Act.”

This bill is a blatant power grab by the GOP, not a good-faith effort to protect elections. It is built on a lie: there is no serious evidence of a non-citizen voting “problem” in federal elections. Countless reviews, audits, and investigations at the state and federal level have shown that cases of non-citizen voting are vanishingly rare and statistically irrelevant—certainly not a justification for dismantling access to the ballot for millions of eligible Americans.

The GOP knows this. They know they cannot win fairly in a genuinely representative electorate. Their standard-bearer is politically toxic, their policies are unpopular, and instead of adjusting to the will of the people, they are trying to manipulate who “the people” are allowed to be. That is not election integrity; it is deliberate voter suppression.

As your constituent abroad, I am especially alarmed because these kinds of proof-of-citizenship and procedural hurdles fall hardest on overseas citizens and military families, who already face logistical challenges just to receive and return a ballot on time. I should not lose my practical ability to vote simply because I am living, working, serving, or studying outside the United States. My rights as a citizen do not stop at the border.

I am asking you to do three things:

1. Publicly and unequivocally oppose the “Save America Act” and vote NO on any version of it.
2. Use your platform—floor speeches, media appearances, social media, and constituent outreach—to make it absolutely clear to the American people that this bill is a partisan attempt to shrink the electorate, not to solve any real problem.
3. Stand firm against any pressure to “compromise” on our fundamental rights. Do not cave to manufactured panic about non-citizen voting that audits and evidence have already debunked.

Democracy depends on elected officials who will defend the franchise even when it might not benefit them politically. I am counting on you to be one of those officials.

Please protect my right to vote as a U.S. citizen abroad and reject this cynical, anti-democratic bill.
