

CERTIFICATED EMPLOYEE INDIVIDUAL CONTRACTS

The board will enter into a written contract with certificated employees, other than administrators, employed on a regular basis. Each contract will be for a period of one year, beginning on dates as determined by the Board of Education, annually.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent to complete the initial contracts for certificated employees and present them to the board for approval. Upon receipt of the contract, the certificated employee will have until the date specified on the contract or the date specified by the board to sign and return the contract to the Superintendent. If contracts are not returned within this period, the position will be considered open and candidates will be secured to fill the vacancy.

A certificated employee may not be required to accept employment for the next school year prior to March 15. The contracts shall be kept on file in the administration offices.
