

Course rules

All players must electronically sign a waiver before playing.

No dogs allowed on the property.

Vehicles on the driveway have priority over disc golfers. The driveway is shared by four property owners so please move out of the way if a vehicle is approaching or driving near where your disc could land. Deliveries come to the barn so please respect these trucks as well.

Several holes are very close to each other and several holes overlap. **Players on the higher number hole always have 'right-of-way.'**

Respect the chickens. We raise chickens and they free range around holes 1 and 2. Before throwing, make sure the landing area is free of chickens. If they are in your landing area, please 'scoot' them away by walking towards them with the arms out from your side. A disc thrown at high speed could kill a chicken.

Respect the trees, bushes and flowers. If your disc does land in an evergreen (mostly likely in the conifer garden), there is a ladder and pvc pipes to help retrieve your disc. **DO NOT BREAK LIMBS OR BRANCHES.** You will be asked to leave if property is damaged.

NO littering. Trash and recycle cans are located at the old barn. Anyone caught littering will be asked to leave. If you see trash on the course, please pick it up.

Smoking is permitted but cigarette butts are considered trash. Please dispose properly. There is a 'no party zone' located on holes one and two.

If a disc lands on the roof of the barn, DO NOT attempt to climb on the roof. It will NOT hold you! There are PVC pipes under the barn and a ladder to use. If your disc lands inside the upper portion of the barn, you can enter from the door but be careful walking on the floor.

If you throw a disc in the pond, we are fine with you entering the pond to retrieve a disc but you should know the bottom is very mushy. The pond is not deep, about 4 feet but there are holes. It is likely you will slip and fall. During the summer, I have a couple of kids who will search for discs. If your phone number is on it, I will contact you.

If your disc lands in the fenced-in dog yard near the green of Hole No. 12, please do not retrieve it. Call Mike and he will get it for you.

Don't approach or enter the old house structure above the parking area. It is unsafe.
