## Contract Terms and Conditions

### All Exhibitor Booths Include: Located in the Graves Arena

- 3' Blue Drapery Backwalls
- 3' Blue Drapery Sidewalls
- 2 Chairs
- One 6' OR 8' Table Skirted in Blue with White Top
- Electricity - One outlet per booth or special outlets that must be requested in advance.

### The following conditions apply:

1. The Exhibitor shall insure his own merchandise against fire, theft and all perils. The Yarmouth County Agricultural Society is not responsible for any loss incurred by any Exhibitor.

2. Exhibit space shall be made available for Exhibitor setup – Tuesday, Aug4th from 10:00 am until 7:00 pm. The building opens, Wednesday Aug5th at 1pm to the general public and we expect your booth to be ready to open as well. If you are not able to arrive during the above setup time, call the exhibition office at 742-8222 to make other arrangements.

3. **Exhibits will remain intact until closing of the Commercial Building and/or grounds** to the general public on the final day of the Exhibition. The building will remain open until 10:30 pm, availing you time to remove carry out items. The building will be open again on Sunday, August 9th from 9am to 10:30am for any remaining items that need to be picked up.

4. Preparation of any exhibit will be at the Exhibitor's expense.

5. Painting or fastening to walls, floors, ceiling, or any part of the building is not permitted. Any damage to the building or show dressings will be the responsibility of the exhibitor. This includes non - fastening items on curtains.

6. Large items or goods may not be delivered, or removed from the building / grounds during show hours without permission of management.
7. Space is to be used for products and purpose of Exhibitor and cannot be sublet or used by anyone other than Exhibitor without written consent of the Leaser.
8. Cancellation policy – Cancellations must be received in writing, non refundable.
9. The Exhibitor must occupy the space allocated to him/her during the scheduled move-in times, unless approved otherwise by Exhibition Management.
10. All applications for space will be dealt with in order of receipt and will be allocated accordingly, if available. The Western Nova Scotia Arts & Heritage shall have full power to determine all space allocations. A floor plan will be available for illustration purpose only. Booth configurations will change as necessary to properly set up the building for the purpose of the show.
11. Show hours are 1 pm to 10 pm daily; however, they are subject to change.
12. There is a \$35.00 charge for the Booth .
13. One 4-day pass plus 1 car pass is included with the rental rate. Additional admissions for booth workers are the responsibility of the Exhibitor and must be purchased or arrangement with the office. Adult daily passes are \$10.00/\$15.00 each or \$35.00 for an Adult Season pass. Car passes are \$5.00
14. **All Food vendors must check to see if they need a food vendor's permit. If required please supply a copy to the Exhibition Office. They have been coming and checking for them so please make sure you have it located in your booth area during the exhibition. 15. **All food vendors MUST attach a complete list of menu items and price list with the application. Our goal is to have booths feature different food options to give our patrons variety in meals. Certain menu items may be restricted at the discretion of the Exhibition and what other food vendors are serving.**
