
Book Recommendations from Mrs. Lacey's Period 5-6




The Percy Jackson Series






I Hunt Killers Series By Barry Lyga




WANT






Twice in a Blue moon By Christina Lauren


The Final Four By Paul Volponi

State in a final four game. It goes back into the life of the players while still connecting that to the game. It brings up actual basketball stuff like how the main character is a one and done.




A Series of Unfortunate Events By: Lemony Snicket Pocommonded By: Mason
