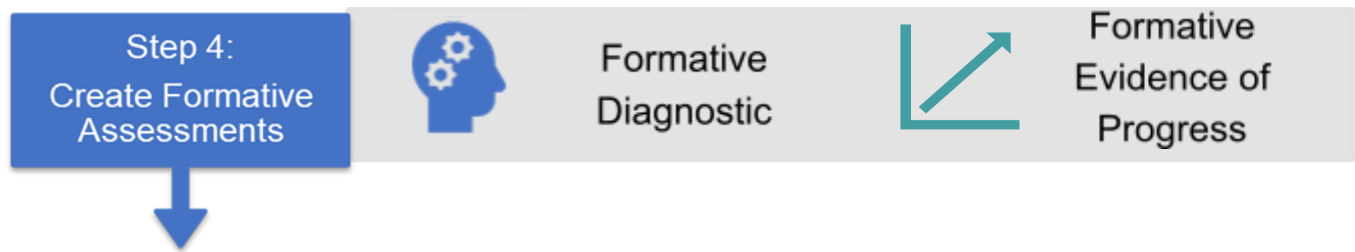

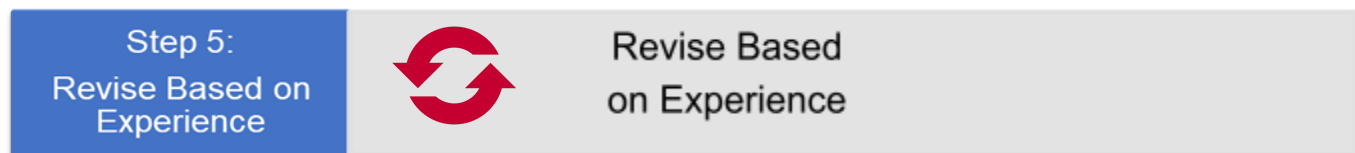
Evidence of Learning

They might include observations / dialogue, academic prompts, graded quizzes /tests/ exams, short constructed response, extended constructed responses, skills check.
