Actions & Assessments

Continue in providing students Social & Emotional Learning class using the Positive Action

Promote culture that values diversity and is sensitive and responsive to diversified cultures and emotional needs of a diverse student population.

Provide additional support to students who are identified with disabilities using research-based interventions.

Initiate school-wide innovative ways throughout the school year to create a school culture that is sensitive and empathetic to one another.

Provide professional learning communities learning opportunities for teachers to make plans and/or evaluate efforts to reduce the removal of students from classrooms for disciplinary reasons.

Goal #2 Curriculum and instruction

To support teachers and administrators in engaging students in all curriculum areas regardless of whether the instruction is delivered in English and Chinese through differentiated data-driven instructions and sharing of best practices that foster creativity, risk-taking and effort.

Actions & Assessment

Ensure all lessons follow a consistent format in all classrooms.

Provide the appropriate and on-going professional development needed for supporting at-risk, ESL, EC, AIG students in general education, special education, ESL, and AIG classrooms.



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Expand repertoire of ways to ensure students are engaged in their learning. Strategies will include consistently and frequently using student discourse in the classroom, technology integration, and applying strategies from i-Ready, IXL, and Lexia.

Meet regularly with a professional learning community to ensure on and above grade-level standards driven curriculum alignment is happening across all grade-level classrooms (vertical alignment).

Provide a multi-tier supporting system(MTSS) schoolwide to meet students' individual needs both in academics and social and emotional learning.

> Provide advanced Mandarin instruction for students who have learned Chinese for three or more years.

Continue in working with Charlotte Mecklenburg Library to support a variety of readers within a classroom

Goal #3 Data and growth

To monitor student progress diagnostically (using i-Ready data) and plan for each student to have the proper support to reach their annual growth goal.

Actions & Assessments

Conduct data meetings (using i-Ready) to track progress and to identify students in need of targeted reading and math interventions.

Conduct data meetings to track progress of EC, ESL, and AIG students toward their annual

Identify a data collection tool for measuring students' social, emotional, and behavioral growth. Create structured time for teachers to look at student work to determine timely next steps to drive instruction.

Continue to improve the MTSS model to include robust and timely Tier 1 support, and Tier 2 and Tier 3 interventions.

SCHOOL WIDE IMPROVEMENT MODEL

The Continuous Improvement Model, an 8-step process, is a research-based program that includes the following steps:

- 1. Administer frequent assessments
- 2. Disaggregate test data to identify instructional groups with challenges and strengths
- Develop and implementAIG, ESL, and MTSS schedule 3.
- Deliver the instructional focus 4.



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- Provide differentiated data-driven instruction to re-teach target areas not mastered and teach above grade level for students who have mastered target areas
- Provide Chinese instruction that builds and strengths Chinese language foundation 6.
- Reinforce and enrich learning through projects and activities 7.
- Monitor progress with data analysis
