- Student must take any 3 credits of CTE or ATC courses.
- Student must have no grade lower than a B in each CTE or ATC courses class.

#### Agricultural - McKayla Plewe

Student must take any three agricultural classes:

Animal Science I, Animal Science II, Equine II, Equine II, Ag Science, Floriculture, Plant and Soil Science I

- Student must have no grade lower than a B in the above-listed courses.
- The student must be a member of FFA for at least two years.

#### Business - Holly Goff or Chase Powell

Student must take four business classes.

- Student must have no grade lower than a B in the above-listed courses.
- The student must be a member of FBLA or DECA for at least two years.

#### Cabinet and Millwork - Todd Thorley

- Student must take Woods 2 AND Wood 3.
- Student must have **no grade lower than a B** in the above-listed courses.

#### CAD - Todd Thorley

- Student must take CAD-Mechanical Design AND CAD-Architectural Design
- Student must have no grade lower than a B in the above-listed courses.
- Student must demonstrate good citizenship with nothing lower than Satisfactory "S" marks.

#### Family and Consumer Science - Laycee Johnson

Student must take any four Family and Consumer Science Classes, one being an advanced course – Foods II, Pro Start, Sewing Construction, Textiles II or Nutrition 1020, and Culinary I.

- Student must have no grade lower than a B in FACS classes.
- Student must be an **active** member of FCCLA for at least two years AND participate in region.

#### **Graphic Arts – Tyler Davis**

- Student must take three classes in 3-D Graphic, Commercial Photo, Screen Printing Technology, and Digital Media.
- Student must have no grade lower than a B in the above-listed courses.
- Student must create a portfolio.

#### **ENGLISH – Erin Hensel**

- Student must have no grade lower than a B in at least four English classes.
- Student must complete either a CE class in English OR take at least one year of Creative Writing and either be published or be an active member of an English-centered extracurricular (Writer's Club, school newspaper, debate team, participate in multiple open-mic performances of original work)
- Student must complete 10 hours of service by tutoring in English (Learning Center, sibling, classmate, neighbor, etc) OR show a justifiable application of skills learned in an English class in two projects (for example, public speaking on behalf of the school, teaching English on a summer service trip, yearbook editor, etc.)

#### **FINE ARTS**

#### Theatre - Richie Uminski

- Student must enroll in and complete four theatre or film courses during high school.
- Student must participate in five full-length productions during high school.
- Student must participate in region/state theatre three times and attend Shakespeare competitions two times.
- Student must maintain a 3.0 Cumulative GPA throughout high school.

#### Music – Winds: Keith Sorensen Strings: Christina Carrigan Vocal: Mark Ganowsky

- The student must be a member of at least one performance group for four years: Winds, Strings, or Vocal.
- Student must participate in an auditioned group for two years in one of the above-listed areas.
- Student must have 100% attendance in all performances including concerts, festivals, and parades during all four years.
- Student must have no grade lower than a B in all performance music classes. Please see your music teacher for concerns.

#### Visual Arts - Brad Stacey / Brandon Wainwright

- Student must take at least three full credits of visual art classes.
- Student must participate in an art club for at least 2 years (Art Guild, Clay Club, Illustration Club, etc.)
- Student must participate in the annual Cedar High Art Show for at least three years.
- Student must have **no grade lower than a B** in all visual arts classes.

#### FOREIGN LANGUAGE - Jeremiah Greene

- Student must take a Foreign Language class for three years. Two years must be in the same language.
- Student must have no grade lower than a B in Foreign Language classes.

#### YEARBOOK – Kodi Quarnberg

- The student must be a member of the yearbook staff for junior and senior years.
- Student must contribute to those publications in a meaningful manner, as determined by the advisor.
- Student must have no grade lower than a B in Yearbook classes.

#### LEADERSHIP - Travis Wood

- Student must be involved in student government or another Cedar High leadership role for at least two years.
- Attend a leadership conference.
- ❖ The student must achieve a 3.5 cumulative GPA.

#### MATHEMATICS - Mark Esplin

- ❖ Student must have **no grade lower than a B** GPA in their math classes.
- Student must have taken four years of mathematics in high school, where one of the courses is Secondary III and the other is either AP Calculus, AP Statistics, Math 1030, Math 1040, or Math 1050.
- The student must complete 10 of their service hours by tutoring other students in math, either at the learning center or in conjunction with a math teacher.

#### PHYSICAL EDUCATION - Cleve Weaver

- Students must have taken at least five semester classes of P.E. The student must demonstrate good citizenship with nothing lower than a satisfactory "S". Athletics cannot count as part of the P.E. classes.
- Student must participate for a minimum of two years **at Cedar High School** in at least one of the following sports: Football, Volleyball, Soccer, X-Country, Tennis, Golf, Basketball, Swimming, Wrestling, Track, Baseball, Softball, Drill, and Cheer.
- Student must have **no grade lower than a B** in all Physical Education courses.
- Student must take a transcript to Mr. Weaver to verify classes taken and sports participation.

#### SCIENCE - Lisa Monson

- Student must take **four** years of Science, with at least **one CE class**, from the following courses: astronomy, geology, earth science, physics, chemistry, biology, anatomy & physiology, Chemistry 1010/15, BIO 1010/15, BIO 1020/25, BIO 1610/15 & Physics 1010/15
- Student must have **no grade lower than a B** in each science class.

#### **SOCIAL SCIENCE – Kyle Hinton**

- Student must have **no grade lower than a B** in each social science class.
- Students must complete either a Cedar High School Advanced Placement class or a Cedar High School concurrent enrollment class in Social Science.
