How to reach the venue

Venue: Asiago Astrophysical Observatory and Croce Bianca Hotel

The venue is located at  Asiago Astrophysical Observatory . The address is: Via Osservatorio Astronomico, 8, 36012 Asiago VI.

Speakers and professors will be hosted by  Hotel Croce Bianca whose address is: Corso IV Novembre, 30, 36012 Asiago VI. Students participating in the Workshop will be hosted by Asiago Astrophysical Observatory.

Reaching Asiago from Padua

The Physics of Data and Societal Challenges Workshop 2023 will take place in Asiago, the beautiful city surrounded by mountains in the North of Padua.

It is possible to reach the Workshop venue in different ways, as described below.

Private organized bus service: reservation is needed, meeting time at 10.30 AM at Largo Egidio Meneghetti, 1, Padua on Monday 25th September. Departure time is shortly after 10.30 AM. In approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes the bus will arrive at Asiago Observatory. The service is available for the return to Padua on Wednesday 27 after lunch. Arrival time in Padua at approximately 17.00

Public bus transportation: reaching Asiago from Padua requires the use of the public bus service SVT, servicing from Vicenza. Vicenza is reachable by train from Padua in about 20 minutes. From Vicenza bus station one has to take line E13 to Thiene bus station and then change to line E23 to Asiago bus station. The journey takes approximately 1 hour 30 minutes. More information here:

Reaching Padua from Venice and Verona airports

In order to reach Padua, it is possible to arrive by train to Padua train station, which is easily connected to Venice and Verona airports.

From Venice Marco Polo Airport: take the direct bus service operated by BusItalia:
