

Tag Checking: Why? How?

- Issues with the Tag Checking tool

The simple one (just precision)

Problem:...

- Issues with the tagset

The tagger kept tagging the word “Hiring” (as in hiring manager, hiring process) as a noun. I don’t think they should be counted as nouns. So, I changed it, but I’m not quite sure either.

(Seda)

The tagger’s precision for the verbs was 100% for my first text, but it missed 6 other past participle verbs (all in -ed form) such as “I also served as...”, “...and implemented plans...”. They were tagged as “VL+ED+”, which seems accurate when I checked the tagset. Similar cases happened with the other texts, too. (Seda)

The tagger tagged “level” as an adjective. It was modifying a noun in this case, but I think it’s still a noun. (Marcella)

- Can you please explain what “attribute only” is? (An)
- Do we have a tag for abbreviations? (pp - for example) (An)
- For nonfinite clauses (e.g, ‘crime committed by...’) do we need to mark PSV? (An)
