2023 Misty Dailey Awards

Art History and Art majors and minors are encouraged to apply for the Annual Misty Dailey Awards. The awards are sponsored by the Dailey Family in memory of their daughter Misty, an Art major at Georgetown.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants may submit work from their junior or senior years and may submit only one paper for consideration. Art History Majors may submit to both the Outstanding Major Research Paper and Outstanding Short Paper categories. Art History Minors may only submit work to the Outstanding Short Paper category. Deadline for applications extended: 12 noon on Wednesday, April 19th, 2023.

Judging & Ceremony

External Guest Judges in Art History and Studio Art will decide the winning work. Students' names should not be included on the work itself, so the work is anonymous to the jurors. Award recipients will be honored at the Misty Dailey Awards Ceremony and Dinner on **Thursday**, **May 11th**, **2023**. Recipients will be notified in advance of their awards.

Students are welcome to edit, revise, or expand the original class paper/project before submitting it. Students **must** consult with the professor for whom the work was initially done before submitting it, and have their professor sign the form. All submissions must be accompanied by the form on the reverse of this sheet, including the instructor's signature, to be eligible.

Art History Prizes

Art History Majors:

- Outstanding Major Research Paper, written during junior or senior year \$500
- Outstanding Short Paper in Art History, written during junior or senior year \$250
- Honorable Mention, Outstanding Major Research Paper, written during junior or senior year -\$100

Art History Minors:

• Outstanding Short Paper, written during junior or senior year - \$250

Art Prizes

Applicants must be **seniors with a declared major in Art.** Submissions will be judged as part of the annual Senior Majors exhibition in the de la Cruz Gallery. *The work included in the Senior Majors exhibition will automatically be considered for a Misty Dailey Art Prize*. All media are eligible. Ask your advisor, art professor, or gallery director for details.

- Outstanding Senior Project in Studio Art, 1st Prize \$500
- Outstanding Senior Project in Studio Art, 2nd Prize \$250
- Honorable Mention \$100

Papers should have a cover page with the title only.

Students may submit only one paper for consideration. Please consult your art history professor and provide a copy of your paper to them in time to allow them to read and approve the paper before the deadline. No papers will be accepted without the approval and signature of a faculty member on the submission form.

Ensure that your paper has this completed form attached to it. Students' names should not be included on the work itself, so the work is anonymous to the jurors. Your name and the professor's name must appear only on the submission form. Do not put your name or your professor's name on the paper itself. *Minors may only submit to the Outstanding Short Paper category.
