IV. New Items for March Report

A. STAR results

- Reading scores down significantly exploring EL curriculum for future improvements - teaching reading concepts is challenging in virtual learning (40 minutes vs. recommended 2 hours) - March Madness plans will target improvement (Saturday academy, individual intervention, etc.)
- Math scores generally up, reflecting impact of Eureka curriculum
- Introduced new DSE subgroup reporting (Department of Special Education)

B. iReady results

- iReady assessment is more adaptive, lengthier, & better predictor of Milestones results than STAR. These assessments will help build stamina, show when individual scholars are racing through the questions, and provide personalized intervention plans. STAR assessments are shorter 15 minute tests, and we are planning to move away from STAR and focus on iReady next school year.
- Lower Academy (K-2) did their assessments in-person in the building, reflecting stronger scores.
- APS is conducting a district wide pilot for iReady, but data for other similar schools is not available from the district. Ms. Lamar will research the ability to compare our performance to other schools.

C. Teacher performance (mid-year)?

- Mr. Heckstall is conducting teacher observations as guided by APS. Results will be reported at the end of the school year.
- TKES results will not be provided this school year.

- A. Scholar attendance
 - Provided Feb 26 (63%)
 - APS direction to not automatically withdraw scholars with more than 10 consecutive absences to remove them from the roll is contributing to low attendance figures
- B. Leadership

 - Scholar involvement was miscalculated in previous months, so numbers are lower for this month.
 - Numbers do not reflect classroom leadership, only schoolwide opportunities, so we will add those classroom level opportunities next school year.
