

Preschool Assistant Teacher

DESCRIPTION:

The Little Blue Creche is a Reggio-inspired nursery school (0-4 years) and coworking space for parents opening this Summer in Ventura, California. Our programs reflect our belief that children learn naturally through play, observation, investigation, and connection. We value each child and partner with families and the community to teach competent learners. We believe that time spent in wild places leads to a strong environmental ethic later in life. Our vision is to rewild childhood to rewild the planet.

We are seeking an Assistant Teacher to support our preschool classroom (2-4 years old) on a daily basis. The ideal candidate will have an Associate's or Bachelor's in Early Childhood Education and an understanding of the Reggio Emilia philosophy and nature-based education.

The pay range for this position is \$18-\$19 per hour (commensurate with experience). We offer a generous benefits package, including medical, dental, vision, retirement options, and childcare scholarships. Four weeks of paid vacation for full-time staff, and seven days of paid sick leave. Unpaid parental leave for at least a year, or the option to return to work and bring their baby with a scholarship. This is a 12-month position. Full details of employment terms and benefits are to be governed by the employment offer letter.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES:

We are seeking a compassionate, reliable, and enthusiastic **Preschool Assistant Teacher** to join our team. This role supports the preschool classrooms, providing nurturing care and engaging learning experiences in a safe and developmentally appropriate environment.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Support lead teachers in implementing a developmentally appropriate curriculum Assist with feeding, toileting, naptime, and general classroom care.
 Maintain a clean, safe, and organized environment in compliance with health and safety regulations.
- Build warm, responsive relationships with children, helping to foster their social-emotional development.
- Supervise children closely and ensure proper ratios are maintained at all times. Communicate effectively and professionally with families and coworkers.
- Observe and document children's developmental progress under the guidance of lead teachers.
- Attend staff meetings, professional development sessions, and training as required.
- Assist with the general hygiene of the children, including, but not limited to, toilet training, diaper changing, washing hands, brushing teeth, cleaning mud or sand off of children, and helping with other activities that may require contact with bodily fluids.
