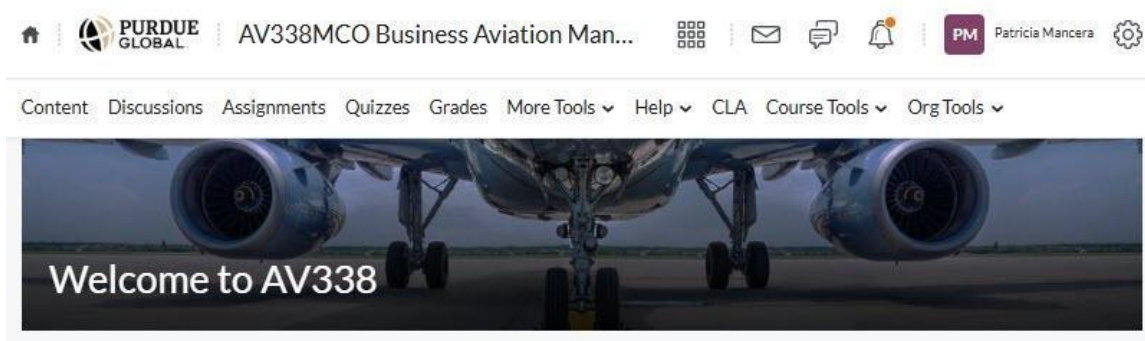

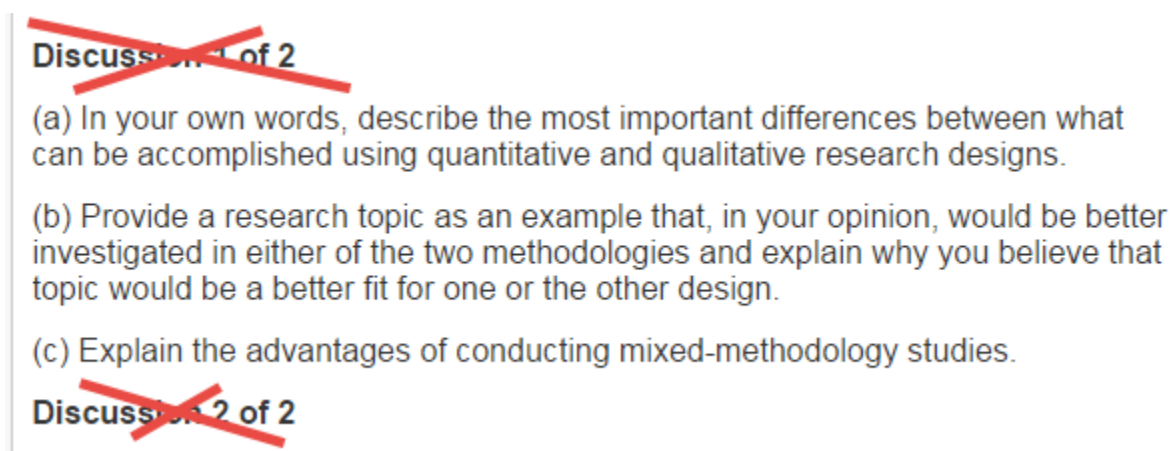
## GET HELP WHEN YOU NEED IT
