



Pets – Pets are allowed but must be picked up after. PETS IN CABIN BY PRIOR APPROVAL ONLY

"Bring your Best" - (6ft and under) double elimination tourney.

"Achilles tourney" – For the Achilles tournament, before each bout the combatants will roll a secret vulnerability die.

A good hit to that area is a killing blow, all other normally legally targeted spots will only be verbally acknowledged, but the fight will continue.

In addition before each bout the combatants will roll a die to determine their weapon selection for that round.

So bring all your toys. (also 6ft and under) Some loaner weapons will be available.
