Day 1: PCH / Ray Miller Trailhead to Decker Road / Mulholland Highway


Day 2: Decker Road / Mulholland Highway to Piuma Road Trailhead

ELEVATION PROFILES



EASTBOUND DATABOOK

This is the rough databook I created to help my hiking buddy and I plan for our thru-hike, with some additional information added afterward. Please note that mileages in the databook may be off slightly here and there, since they're based on map data rather than on-the-ground GPS data. This is not meant to be a guidebook or a perfect list of data points in any way, but hopefully it *does* help in your general planning!

[W] = dependable water source

[W] = seasonal / unreliable water source

[C] = campground

T = toilet

TH = trailhead

TR = trail

Mtwy = Motorway (fire road)

\$ = costs money

Mile 0.0 – [T] [C] Ray Miller TH (Point Mugu State Park)

- Need permission from the State Park to park overnight; \$
- 2.7 hang left on Overlook TR, which is a fire road
- **4.6** turn right Wood Canyon Vista TR (Backbone signage on post is worn off)
 - [C] [T] Can depart just ahead to hike to La Jolla Valley walk-in CG; pit toilet; \$
- 6.4 W Spigot on yellow pole at junction with dirt Sycamore Canyon Road, head left
- 6.5 Stay straight and ignore road on your left
- 7.1 stay on road, ignore Old Boney Trail on your right
- 7.6 stay straight & ignore fire road on your left
- 7.8 entrance to Danielson Ranch / Blue Canyon now on Blue Canyon Trail
- 8.0 [W] [T] [C] Danielson Ranch Group Campground (water spigot) \$
 - Must reserve ahead of time; very pricey
- 8.1 [W] possible water in canyon if it's been wet
- 8.6 Stay down in canyon & ignore Old Boney Tr to your left
- 9.7 on a long saddle now
 - Ignore trail to right (Old Boney again) & head up to your left toward rocky ridgeline to pick up Chamberlain Trail; walk just over 3 miles along rocky spine
- 12.8 1st side trail to Tri-Peaks on left
- 13.3 2nd Tri-Peaks TR departs to your left
- 14.4 Sandstone Peak use trails begin appearing on your right
- 15.2 hang left onto Mishe Mokwa Connector TR
- 15.4 Mishe Mokwa TR departs to your left; stay right and head down
- 16.0 Ti Mishe Mokwa TH at Yerba Buena Road / Trifuno Pass
 - parking & portable toilet; be careful crossing road
- 20.5 Cross Yerba Buena / Little Sycamore Canyon Road
- 21.1 meet up with Etz Meloy Mtwy fire road
- **22.4** depart onto singletrack which winds down down
- 25.0 Decker Road / Mulholland Highway
- 26.3 T Encinal Canyon Rd
 - Paved parking, outhouses, picnic table
 - trail actually continues to your left, across Encinal not straight ahead (which takes you to Agony trail)
 - [W] Water is available at the Malibu Conservation Camp fire station at the end of Rattle Snake Road
- 26.8 Now in Zuma / Trancas Canyon
 - [W] Possible water down in canyon if it's been wet
- 27.9 brief linkup with Edison Rd fire road
- 28.0 depart fire road
- **28.5** join Zuma Ridge Mtwy for short bit
- 28.6 depart Zuma Ridge Mtwy on singletrack to your right
- **30.2** [W] Possible water in Zuma Creek if it's been wet

- best accessed on the far side of the bridge
- 31.1 T Kanan Dume Rd
 - pit toilets, shaded bench, big parking area
- 33.4 Latigo Cyn Rd
- 34.4 Cross Newton Mtwy
 - [W] possible water down in Upper Solstice Canyon if it's been wet
- **36.4** briefly join, then depart another unpaved road (Edison?)
- **37.0** Corral Canyon (Malibu Creek State Park)
 - pick up single track (mostly walking ON rock, then a brief singletrack segment)
- **37.4** join Mesa Peak Motorway (fire road)
- 40.0 hairpin turn, ignore Puerco Cyn Rd, which appears twice on your right
- 41.8 side road to Tapia Water Treatment Plant private property, stay right
- 42.4 W Tapia TH / Tapia TH)
 - Bathrooms, parking \$
 - Follow Backbone for a short bit to Tapia Park, then walk through the park & pick up the Tapia Spur Trail to reach Malibu Creek SP for [C] (\$, reserve ahead of time); site #3 is right by the connector trail
- 44.3 Piuma Ridge TH at Piuma Rd
 - [W] Possible water in Cold Creek if it's been wet
- 47.5 Side trail for Stunt Rd, goes to your left
- 48.7 Junction of trail to Saddle Peak (straight to stay on Backbone)
- 49.5 briefly join w/ Stunt Rd, with great views across Lois Ewen Overlook
 - continue past the signs on Topanga Tower Mtwy
- 49.6 look for singletrack departing on your right
- 50.2 begin long switchback descent on Hondo Cyn TR
- **53.0** [W] possible water crossing the trail here if it's been wet
- 53.5 Old Topanga Cyn Blvd
 - [W] possible water in the creek if it's been wet, just before reaching the road
 - [W] Topanga Creek General Store & restaurants about 0.5 mi off-trail, south on Old Topanga Canyon Rd
 - After crossing, pass Henry Ridge Tr and Greenleaf Rd connector, going right here down to Topanga Canyon Road
- 54.2 W T Topanga State Park Dead Horse TH
 - Bathrooms & water fountain
- 55.5 W Trippet Ranch Rd
- **56.4** [W] [T] [C] Musch Camp, \$
- **57.5** climb up to Eagle Junction, where you'll hang a left on the East Topanga Fire Road
 - pass Eagle Rock side trail on right not long after

- **58.0** stay straight; pass Chaney Fire Rd and Garapito Tr, which depart close to each other on left
- 58.8 T Hub Junction
 - shade, bench, pit toilet
 - head right (south) from here
- 59.4 depart fire road to pick up singletrack Temescal Ridge TR on left
 - Just after this junction, there's a side trail on left to 2126' Temescal Peak
 - eventually turns into Rogers Fire Road, which winds down (and occasionally up)
 a series of ridgelines alongside Temescal Canyon
- **64.3** Junction with connector trail to Rustic Canyon, which goes to your left; stay straight
- 64.7 Chicken Ridge Bridge
- 66 Enter Will Rogers SP & intersect the Inspiration Point Loop Trail
 - detour 0.1 mi to Inspiration Point for excellent views
- 67 W T Will Rogers TH (Will Rogers State Historic Park)
 - Bathrooms, parking \$
