The name **RED** represents the organization's three key objectives:

- **Remembering** the lives and lessons of our movement.
- **Educating** communities with knowledge and resources to promote health, wellness, and prevention services.
- **Defeating** stigma, barriers to care, and the conditions that prevent individuals and families from thriving.

Collectively, The NJ RED Collective provides a comprehensive network of services that touch every corner of New Jersey. These include:

- Prevention, testing, and harm reduction programs
- Access to life-saving medical care
- Counseling, mental health, and substance use resources
- Housing, hygiene, and nutrition
- Advocacy for equitable healthcare access
