What is a Dental Implant?

A dental implant is a fixture that is embedded within the jaw bone and replaces natural teeth by supporting a prosthesis, such as a crown or removable or fixed denture. After the placement of dental implants, bone formation occurs in the surroundings of the implant, resulting in firm anchorage and stability of the artificial tooth.

How Do Dental Implants Work?

The success and excellent durability of dental implants is dependent upon their ability to form direct contact with the surrounding jaw bone. This process is known as osseointegration and ensures that any prosthesis that is placed over the implant remains retained and stable, thereby restoring optimal functioning of the artificial tooth.

Who Should Get an Implant?

In general, any person who has one or more missing natural teeth is a candidate for an implant. You should consider getting an implant if:

- You want a long term and durable replacement for your missing natural teeth.
- You want to restore your facial esthetics by getting your missing teeth replaced.

- You want to get rid of your inconvenient and uncomfortable dentures.

Dental implants are gaining widespread popularity as the most convenient and durable replacement option for missing teeth. Let's have a look why you might prefer them over other tooth replacement options, such as dentures and bridges:

- Enjoy a Beautiful Smile - Loss of a tooth can ruin your smile and facial esthetics. Esthetically pleasing dental prosthesis can be placed over the implants, thereby restoring your beautiful smile and charming appearance.
- Durability - Unlike the dentures and dental bridges, dental implants are designed to last forever. If you take proper care of your oral health and adhere to your dentist's instructions regarding the care of the implants, you can expect them to function for a lifetime.
- Minimal Requirement for Tooth Preparation - Fabrication of teeth bridges, even for the replacement of a single tooth requires reduction of the adjacent teeth as well. On the other hand, placement of dental implants does not require any preparation or reduction of the adjacent teeth, thereby preserving the natural tooth structure.
