Getting to school	Our school, located in the south of Seville, is approximately a 20 minute train ride from Santa Justa train station or a 30 minute bus ride from the city centre. Seville also has a well developed network of bike lanes, so it is possible to get to our school by bicycle quite easily.  • By bus. The name of the company running the public bus service is Tussam and this is their link:  https://www.tussam.es/en. The buses that come closest to our school are numbers 3, 37 and LS (Línea Sur – South Line). Note that LS is an express bus line and therefore has less bus stops. It is highly recommended that you download the app Tussam on your smartphone as soon as you arrive in Seville.  • By train. The name of the company running the train service is Renfe and this is their link:  https://www.renfe.com/es/en/suburban/suburban-seville/timetables Note that the closest train station to our school is Jardines de Hércules and it is a 15 minute walk from the school. The commuter lines are C1 and C5. "C" stands for "Cercanías" (Commuter).  • By bicycle. The name of the company in charge of this service is SEVICI and their link is this:  https://www.sevici.es/en/home	
Accommodation	Unfortunately, accommodation has become expensive in the past few years in Seville. The best thing to do is to rent a room and share the flat with other people.
