Show Canisius College Instructors how to activate and use Panopto in their class.

Script

Hello everyone. My name is Tyler Kron-Piatek from COLI at Canisius. In this video, we will go over how to activate and use Panopto.

Panopto is a Video Content Management System that allows you to quickly and easily create, edit, and share videos with your class. There are several ways to access and add Panopto videos to a Course Activity or Module. In this tutorial, we will use Add Existing Activities.

Add Existing activities will be the fastest way to get videos into your course module. In a course module, find and select the Add Existing Activities button. This will activate a drop down menu. Select the first option, "Add Panopto Media".

If you have the "This folder is empty" message, you can quickly upload or record videos directly to Panopto by clicking on the respective tabs.

Select a video that you want to insert. Then click on the "Insert" button in the lower right corner. A link to the video will be added to the content area of the module. The link text will take on the title of your video. To change the link text, click on the dropdown arrow to the right of the title. Then click on Edit Properties in Place. This will allow you to change the link text as well as add a description.

When you make these changes, you may need to reload the webpage to actually see them take affect.
