- ■Mrs. Fox shared the LCAP slides with the team and reviewed the goals, strategic plan and key terms.
- ■Ada Lee reviewed the goals from previous years and how we did with the goals, reminding the team that this was during the COVID pandemic
- •Mrs. Fox shared that our achievement has continued to grow since the pandemic unlike many districts in the state.
- ■Mrs. Fox reviewed the recent student outcomes for Mariposa. There is some improvement with attendance for Mariposa.
- •Ms. Gulati shared recent student outcomes for TL
- ■The team was asked to give feedback, ask questions about the new LCAP goals:
 Purnima asked how do we measure intrapersonal growth? Where is the cultural awareness piece in the goals?
- Purnima suggested adding verbiage to goal #4 to add and <u>infrastructure safe</u>
 to the well maintained, climate ready environment
- ■Charu reviewed the student growth based on the IReady assessments-there was growth in both ELA and math with students testing at grade level and the number of students testing below grade level decreased. This is a positive trend they hope to continue.
- ■Theresa shared the chronic absenteeism-it went from 4/8% to 6% from January 2024 to March 2028
- ■Theresa shared 2nd Trimester Math Benchmark for MPA-4th and 5th grade students as well Reading (F&P) scores (Fall and Winter)

- Jennifer Gaboury reviewed the SCSD safety plan-slides linked on agenda
- Marty said we should practice different scenarios—such as a plan A, Plan B.
 Things don't always go as planned or practiced
- Purnima asked Ms. Gaboury some questions for clarification on the different tiers and safety plan as well as who administers the medication to reverse a drug overdose—Is it a nurse? Are there nurses on every campus—Charu confirmed there are not, but nurses of course are trained.
- Purnima also suggested that the infrastructure of the schools also be part of the safety plan-such as updated wiring, AC for cooling, etc....
- Mrs. Fox went over the attendance numbers at Mariposa.
- Charu went over the TL attendance numbers. TL's numbers for absences are high across all student groups. They have a problem with not just travel, but many students are exhibiting school refusal. Jeanne asked about incentives to make students want to come to school. Charu shared some of the reasons why some are chronically absent—some don't have the connections/friends at school, not doing well in school overall.
- Charu went over the TL wellness Sneak peak. Jeanne asked what is happening in the classroom to help with the feeling of belonging-are there smiles? Due to the time, Mrs. Fox said we can add this to the next meeting's agenda.

- Ada Lee did share some things that are going on in the classroom right now.
- Kylene Shen asked about resources—more resources to have friendship groups at the upper elementary and middle school level—just as important or even more important than at the elementary level.

- Theresa Fox reviewed Mariposa's goal along with the school plan for Student Achievement. School plan is aligned with the district LCAP goals—
- Theresa discussed the EL students and the reclassification process and importance of being able to reclassify before the 5th year in the district.
- Mari asked if the EL instruction was in the classroom or if students are pulled out.
 Mrs. Fox and Mrs. Juliano explained that EL instruction is within the general education classroom. There is opportunity for small group instruction in the learning center as well—where they are often pulled with their non-EL peers.
- Purnima asked about incorporating mini PBL's where students had opportunities to practice public speaking.

- Purnima asked about the belonging part in DEIB-and how we get more
 mainstream with including all cultures—bringing events to the school. Ms. Gulati
 and Mrs. Fox shared what both schools are currently doing.
- Kylene asked how Mariposa helps all students understand student differences—
- Purnima suggested that we have something where we help with the pronunciations of names as well as where our names came from.
- Ms. Gulati reviewed the TL goals with the group
- Purnima asked how the math information for a student is transferred from MPA to
 TL-Mrs. Fox said we do have a transition document but it doesn't have specific
 math data-TL gives a math benchmark in the beginning of the year. There is data
 that is shared-spreadsheets with students of concern for example. Purnima
 expressed that it seems it would be helpful for the incoming school to be aware of
 the students who are coming in needing extra help.
- Irina shared that parent participation is important and could be invaluable in the language learning process.Ms. Gulati shared that the current TL students are very motivated to do well. Currently, peers are also helping the new EL learners.
- Purnima asked if TL has something like the Monarch council—Ms. Gulati shared TL has ASB (associated student body), so yes something similar.
- Purnima asked about one platform for all schools to help with one system for
 parents to go to—save on numerous emails, and perhaps this might help with
 parent engagement. Ms. Gulati agrees that it would be helpful to streamline the
 communication. Irina shared her ideas too.

- Review of EL: English Learner. Irina asked what interventions are put in place to help the ELL students to be proficient in English. Mrs. Fox explained what is done at Mariposa
- Mrs. Fox reviewed Next Steps and the goals such as increasing academic achievement and creating a systemic structure that fosters the 5 C's.
- Ms. Gulati reviewed the SPSA goals from 2022-2023. Goals were achieved and continual progress monitoring will help guide for next steps and to compare last year and this year's data.
- Reviewed SBAC results/TL-discussed what interventions are put in place to help students who
 need extra support-for example-Rtl support class (Response to Intervention). By 8th grade the
 goal and hope is that a student won't need an intensive support class but rather a co-taught
 class. ELA goal met, but Math goal not met.
- TL data for ELA shows the goal is partially met-improvement with students who have met or nearly met standards. Same for math
- DEIB goals-more work to be done in this area-data that is gathered doesn't give a lot of qualitative data.
- Ada and Charu went over proposed goals for 2023-2024.
- Mrs. Fox shared with the team due to time-that goals will be presented and then at the Nov.
 16th meeting, they will ask for feedback so that they can bring these to the school board in December.

- Theresa Fox Reviewed the Emergency Response Plan-Mariposa and TL had their first drill last week. It went well. Charu Gulati shared the schedule of the drills. They choose to do them at different times. They don't set off any alarms or do a full lock down drill with students—but have staff prepared. Both schools also got walkie talkies so that every classroom has one. The principals have a communication plan with the Carlmont principal as well as local police departments in both San Carlos and Belmont since we are right along the border of 2 cities. They also keep paper copies of emergency information and student schedules in case of power outage, wifi outage, etc..
- Mari asked about volunteers and their role on campus during an emergency.
- Theresa shared that each year, the local law enforcement and district maintenance staff walk around the MPA campus to see where they could make it more secure.
- Marti brought up the concern with students on their phones and calling home to get picked up—when in an emergency/shelter in place/lock down emergency.
 This could possibly create another problem/emergency.
- Marjan asked about students who were in bathrooms during an emergency-this
 would be the search and rescue team who would go find them—walkies talkies to
 be used during a shelter in place to alert staff.
- Mrs. Fox and Mrs. Gulati went over the SBAC data from across the SCSD for ELA and Math.
- Mrs. Fox shared the Mariposa School Goals for 2023-2024. She has been adding more community activities to foster belonging and community—such as Are you Smarter than a Fifth grader?, Stem night
- Mrs. Gulati shared the Tierra Linda School Goals for 2023-2024
