Learning Module #2 Final Writeup.

Topics Covered: Within Jonathan and Tanner's initial proposal, it states they would be completing a learning module in soldering and would work on a weight calculator as a side project for a wrestling coach. By the second day of the learning module most of Jonathan's and Tanner's time was invested in the weight class calculator and creating a website for it, the module was then switched to html code. Tanner already knew this coding format and used it on the calculator as Jonathan began taking an online course and shadowed Tanner as he changed his code and made updates to the calculator.

What We Learned: Jonathan had no experience in website development and design at first, He learned the basics in the coding format of the design and made the page. He also learned how to form the UI in a website from Tanner and his code. A lesson both Jonathan and Tanner learned from Mr. Detrick was about the issue about how programmers working for the client would get off track track attempting to solve the problem the client has but not in the way the client wants, he explained how often we know what the person wants but we need to give them what they asked for, then supply them with suggestions to addon to the program.

Problems Encountered and Solutions: An issue Jonathan and Tanner encountered time and time again was the question of what was the product the coach wanted. The email specified how the calculator and the output should look like, but in the process of creating the calculator, Tanner would bring up other statistics and information that should be included in an accurate body weight calculator.
