## **PROM INFORMATION:**

- 1) This year's prom (theme: The Roaring 20's) will be at the Lawrenceburg Event Center on Saturday, May 2, 2020.
- 2) Prom Tickets will be on sale Monday, March 2 Friday, April 17. The cost per ticket is \$50 (checks can be made payable to LHS Activities) and can be purchased in the cafeteria during lunch ONLY. Career Center Students may purchase tickets in the front office.
- 3) Prom tickets may ONLY be purchased by a member of the current LHS Junior or Senior class
- 4) When purchasing a ticket, you will be required to choose the table you would like to sit at during Prom. Students wishing to sit together need to purchase their tickets the same day, as switching and/or reserving tables will NOT be permitted this year. Each table seats 10 people and the walkthrough time for that table will be listed when purchasing the tickets.

- 5) Each Junior/Senior is permitted to bring ONE guest outside of the current LHS Junior or Senior class. If the Junior/Senior chooses to walk through Prom Preview, their outside guest must walk with them. The guest must be seated at the same table as the Junior/Senior. Prom Preview (walkthrough) will be held at LHS. After prom preview, you will be responsible for transportation to Prom.
- 6) Any guest who is not a current LHS student will require an LHS approved permission slip which can be picked up in the front office and must be received no later than Wednesday, April 29. Guests must be at least high school age and no older than 20 years old.
- 7) Any student attending Prom must have an extra curricular drug consent form on file. Drug consent forms can be found in the front office. If you are unsure if you have a drug consent form on file, please ask the front office.

# Here are the guidelines pertaining to Prom attire.

#### Dresses:

- 1. No low cut in the front
- 2. The back has to be at least a hand length above the butt (no low backs)
- 3. The slit can only be up to two inches above the knee
- 4. The belly button has to be covered so any midriff baring dresses have to open above the belly button and only an inch of stomach showing.
