Lesson Objectives

Students will:

 - ✓ Share ideas for a Ramadan class corner
 - ✓ Participate in collaborative planning

Lesson Stages

1. Warm-Up (5 min)

Teacher asks:

- What do people do in Ramadan?
- How can we celebrate Ramadan in class?

 Quick brainstorming, short answers.

Purpose: Activate background knowledge.

2. Pre-Reading (7 min)

- Matching activity yapılır.
- Telaffuz birlikte tekrar edilir.

Purpose: Reading comprehension kolaylaştırma.

3. While-/ After Reading (15 min)

- Diyalog önce öğretmen okur.
- Önerilerin altı çizdirilerek metin hakkında farkındalık oluşturulur.
- Sonra öğrenciler role-play yapar.
- Sorular cevaplanır.

Purpose:

- ✓ Reading comprehension
 - ✓ Speaking fluency

Students:

- Fikirlerini paylaşır
- Sınıf birlikte karar verir
- Gönüllü görev listesi oluşturulur
