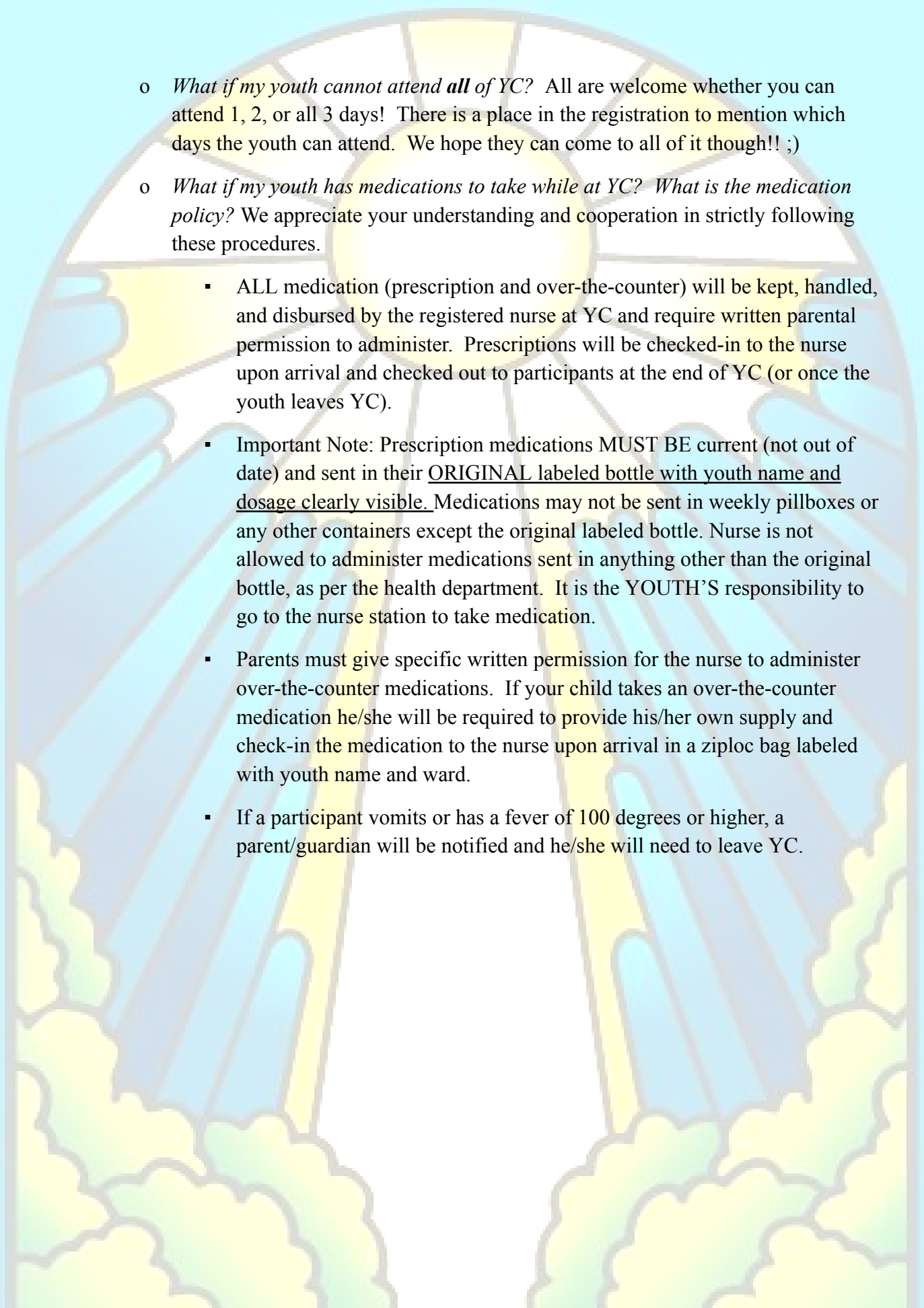

- **Q and A Section Ongoing...**

- o *How will sleeping arrangements be decided?* All youth and adults will be camping in tents. (All attendees {both youth and adults} will be responsible to coordinate overnight tents. Ward adult youth leaders are a great resource for families to coordinate with. Please label all things coming to youth conference with first/last name and ward). Young Women and Young Men will have separate sleeping quarters and will be monitored throughout the night. Youth will be generally camping as wards, but if youth would like to share tents with youth in other wards, both overnight ward leaders need to be informed so all youth are accounted for. Adult Youth leaders will oversee their own wards for camping. There will be 2 Adult Leaders with youth at all times. We will be following guidelines from Handbook 20.5.5 Overnight Activities (Link: [20. Activities](#)) for safety. Please refer to this link for rules regarding tents, etc.
- o *Are there bathrooms on the premises?* There are indoor bathrooms as well as porta potties on site.
- o *Are there showers on the premises?* There are NO shower facilities. Please bring deodorant, wet wipes, hand sanitizer, or any other items to keep clean. We recommend showering just before YC begins if possible and all attendees will definitely need a shower when they return home. lol
- o *Inclement Weather Plan:* We have the church building reserved as a back up if weather permits us from camping. We will not camp overnight at the church if we have to move locations. There will be covered options at Bar 17 Arena if there is light rain though.
- o *When will the youth receive their youth conference tshirts?* All youth will receive their youth conference tshirts at check in on March 7th and will be required to wear them on Saturday. If by chance a youth is unable to register by the deadline, we cannot guarantee a tshirt. We will order a few extras, but cannot guarantee a shirt for youth after the deadline of registration. We still want all youth who can attend to come! All are welcome as long as they register!! :)
- o *Will electronic devices be allowed at youth conference?* Only phones. There will not be a place to plug in and charge though and the service is very spotty. No other devices will be allowed at YC (gaming consoles, iPads, laptops, etc).
- o *What will the food be like?* We are bringing our own food crew and food so the food will be tasty and the youth will be well fed. All communicated **allergies** will be accommodated! There is a place in registration to communicate allergies.

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- o *What if my youth cannot attend **all** of YC?* All are welcome whether you can attend 1, 2, or all 3 days! There is a place in the registration to mention which days the youth can attend. We hope they can come to all of it though!! ;)
 - o *What if my youth has medications to take while at YC? What is the medication policy?* We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in strictly following these procedures.
 - ALL medication (prescription and over-the-counter) will be kept, handled, and disbursed by the registered nurse at YC and require written parental permission to administer. Prescriptions will be checked-in to the nurse upon arrival and checked out to participants at the end of YC (or once the youth leaves YC).
 - Important Note: Prescription medications **MUST BE** current (not out of date) and sent in their ORIGINAL labeled bottle with youth name and dosage clearly visible. Medications may not be sent in weekly pillboxes or any other containers except the original labeled bottle. Nurse is not allowed to administer medications sent in anything other than the original bottle, as per the health department. It is the YOUTH'S responsibility to go to the nurse station to take medication.
 - Parents must give specific written permission for the nurse to administer over-the-counter medications. If your child takes an over-the-counter medication he/she will be required to provide his/her own supply and check-in the medication to the nurse upon arrival in a ziploc bag labeled with youth name and ward.
 - If a participant vomits or has a fever of 100 degrees or higher, a parent/guardian will be notified and he/she will need to leave YC.
