### Question Tags

He was such a weird guy, \_\_\_\_\_?

The car was destroyed, \_\_\_\_\_?

You don't actually plan to leave the country, \_\_\_\_\_?

### **Do is also helpful because it means you don't have to repeat the verb:**

- Larry excelled in language studies; so \_\_\_\_\_ his brother.
