OB Call Workgroup Updates Recording: 33:03 – 1:01	2025.10.07 OB Meeting Call Workgrc • The weekend 12-hour shift option for the residency call group is live as of the Jan 1 call schedules. ◦ This change was discussed at the June OB Faculty Mtg, voted on via Qualtrics survey, results communicated via email in August and talked about at the Sept OB Faculty Retreat. Discussion about communication styles and preferences (including frequency, verbal and written) took place. ◦ The June survey from the OB Call Workgroup asked people to specify their preferences for 12-hour only or 24-hour only call, or no preference. The OB Call Workgroup will send out another survey asking people to confirm or update their 12 vs 24hr shift preferences. • The OB Call workgroup presented their initial proposal to combine the residency and community call groups at the Sept retreat. That model included a 1st call and 2nd call. ◦ During that conversation, there were questions about delivery numbers. Morgan shared the delivery totals for the Residency and Community call groups for FY25. The numbers do not include labors managed that went to c-section. C/s data is not currently available. ◦ There is interest in more data around deliveries that are managed by the FMONS team/on-call person where the continuity provider later comes in to complete the delivery. ◦ Morgan shared updates to other questions and concerns brought up at the retreat (slide 4). • Morgan presented a revised proposal. ◦ Slides 6-11 ◦ FMONS attending takes Daytime 1st call. ◦ Community group takes Daytime 2nd call (equivalent to current rounding weeks). ◦ Residency/Access group takes Overnight 1st call. 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	- o Community group takes Overnight 2nd call Mon-Thurs. - o Residency/Access and Community group will rotate Fri-Sun Overnight 2nd call. • Timeline: the workgroup hopes the model will be voted on by summer 2026 for a Jan 1, 2027 implementation. • The workgroup will send out a survey to have faculty vote if they should continue to explore this model, not a vote of this specific model. • Faculty had further questions about: - o What is the effect of this model on managing labors but the continuity provider still coming in for the delivery? - o Would this model enable other providers to provide prenatal care but not do deliveries? How would this impact volume of labor management and deliveries?
