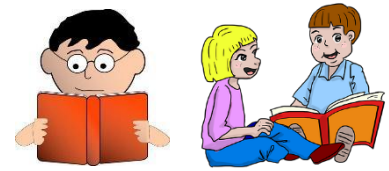






Go for it 6B. Reading Challenge of 250 minutes
