COVID Guidance - 2024-2025

Approved by the Board August 2024

Track and Isolate Positive Cases:

- **If an individual tests positive**
 - SHCSC has approved to eliminate restrictive COVID guidelines
 - COVID is being treated as any other communicable illness

Close Contacts and Quarantines

- IDOH no longer recommends contact tracing and quarantining in schools.
- South Harrison will still notify parents if we feel there is a significant exposure to COVID-19 at school, such as a cluster or outbreak.

Symptomatic Students or Staff

- A negative test or doctor's note is no longer required to return to school. As with other illnesses, students should not return to school unless they are fever free for at least 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication.

Cleaning

- Schools will continue with cleaning, sanitizing, and hygiene protocols.

Additional Considerations

- Should the data or state guidance dictate a shift, this policy can be adjusted by request of the Superintendent. Should this have to occur, it could take place as a corporation, individual buildings, or individual classrooms.
