General

- Little League is an all-volunteer organization. There are NO paid positions. We depend on volunteers to make the league function. You depend on these volunteers so that your child has a place to play youth baseball. Please volunteer your time and be considerate of those that do volunteer.
- Your team will be required to volunteer in the concession stand during your games 1 hour per game when playing on field #4. This can be broken up into shifts if so desired.
- There will be no coaching your child from outside the gate. If you wish to coach your child, please volunteer to coach and go through the background check to qualify.
- There will be NO use of foul language at the ball park.
- The ball park is a non-smoking park entirely.
- No alcohol at the ball park.
- There will no yelling at the coaches or umpires or questioning their calls.
- If you have a question or concern please bring it to the attention of the director on duty at that time. He will either address or bring it to the board at the next meeting for discussion.
- We want everyone to have fun at all times at the ball field, however please remember that this is a youth sports organization. Please govern yourself accordingly.
- There are NO ties in LL baseball or forfeits. You go back to the last complete inning played to establish the winner if the inning and time limit has been met.
- A team cannot take the field with less than the 9 players. If a team is short, they have the option of borrowing a defensive player from the other team or taking a "pool" player from another team within the league to fill in. This must be approved by the opposition.
- Please refer to the LL rule book and app for any specific questions regarding rules and regulations. If you need/want a copy please ask a board member, we will be happy to get you one.
- Pitch count and days of rest required will be watched carefully. Coach found violating the pitch count policy is subject to suspension.
- Any coach, player or parent found violating any rule will be issued a warning. If the offense is repeated, he/she will be suspended one game. Any ensuing violation will be

reviewed by the board for possible removal/banning from future participation at the park.

- Divisions after Minor B will participate in Tournament of Champion tournament at the district level. This will be the winner of the regular season. NOT the winner of the tournament.
- Divisions after minor B will be eligible for the ALL STAR team. The team will be selected by votes from the players. The top 8 vote getters will automatically be on the team. The remaining players will be selected by the coaches. The coaching staff will be selected by the board of directors.

Tee Ball Rules

- We do not keep score at this age.
- Both sides bat twice and everyone bats once from each team. There is a 1 hour time limit.
- The last batter of the inning runs all of the bases for a home run.
- Please flip your lineup after each inning so someone else gets the HR and rotate the lineup each week.
- When a player makes an out we do not remove the runner from the base and 3 outs do not constitute the end of an inning. Everyone batting in the inning ends the inning.
- We ask that you congratulate the player making the out. Also discuss with the player that was out. However, we want them to stay on the bases. We do not want hurt feelings but we are trying to teach outs.
- The coach will throw 4 pitches to the batter. If a ball is not put in play in those pitches, we then go to the tee until the ball is put in play.
- There is no extra bases. Singles only. Base to base.

Minor B

- 1 hour and 30 minute time limit or 6 innings.
- 5 run max per inning; this is continuous where any runs may score after 5 total until the out is made. Example; bases loaded, you have scored 4 in the inning. The batter hits a home run. You will count ALL the runs scoring 8 in the inning.
- Open scoring in the last inning. This is the 6th inning, not the last inning by time restrictions.
- The player will throw 4 (kid) pitches. If a ball is not put in play or a strike out has not been obtained, the coach will throw 3 pitches. There are no hit by pitches, strike outs or walks by the coaches. If the child does not hit one of these he/she is considered an out.
- When the coach pitch is in effect. The position player of pitcher must be positioned next to the pitcher on either side with 1 foot on the grass and 1 foot on the clay.

- There are NO steals.
- The base runner may not advance past the base he is approaching once the ball is secured in the infield.
- You may advance one base on an overthrow only.
- Molded cleats only are allowed. NO metal.
- Any ruling in question will be decided by the director on duty. Once you allow the next pitch to be thrown, you forfeit the right to appeal the previous call.
- There will be an end of the year tournament with the teams in the division.

Minor A

- 1 hour and 30 minute time limit or 6 innings.
- 5 run max per inning; this is continuous where any runs may score after 5 total until the out is made. Example; bases loaded, you have scored 4 in the inning. The batter hits a home run. You will count ALL the runs scoring 8 in the inning.
- Open scoring in the last inning. This is the 6th inning, not the last inning by time restrictions.
- This is an all kid pitch division with walks, passed balls and steals.
- A base runner may steal only after the ball crosses the plate.
- No infield fly rule, balks or dropped 3rd strike rules used at this level.
- Molded cleats only are allowed. NO metal.
- There will be an end of the year tournament with the teams in the division
- Any ruling in question will be decided by the director on duty. Once you allow the next pitch to be thrown, you forfeit the right to appeal the previous call.

Majors

- 1.45 hour time limit or 6 innings.
- No run limit in any inning.
- Infield fly rule in place.
- Dropped 3rd strike rule in place.
- NO balks.
- A base runner may steal only after the ball crosses the plate.
- There will be an end of the year tournament with the teams in the division.

50/70

- 2 hour time limit or 7 innings.

- No run limit in any inning.
- Infield fly rule in place.
- Dropped 3rd strike rule in place.
- Balks will be called.
- Steals are allowed.
- Metal cleats are allowed.
- There will be an end of the year tournament with the teams in the division.

Junior/Senior/Big League

- 2 hour time limit or 7 innings
- No run limit in any inning.
- Infield fly rule in place.
- Dropped 3rd strike rule in place.
- Balks will be called.
- Steals are allowed.
- Metal cleats are allowed.
- There will be an end of the year tournament with the teams in the division.
