INTRODUCTION (Capitalized, Bold, Tahoma 11pt)

Each paragraph uses *the Special* function (*First Line* (new paragraph) with a size of 1 cm in, Tahoma 11pt, 1 space (single line spacing), Justify).¹ *(footnote)*

The introduction must contain the background of the problem that is the focus of the study, literature review of several research results or other people's studies.

METHOD (Capitalized Letters, Bold, Tahoma 11pt)

Each paragraph uses *the Special* function (*First Line* (new paragraph) with a size of 1 cm in, Tahoma 11pt, 1 space (single line spacing), Justify).

Research methods are written based on the type of article, if the type of article is conceptual then "Method" is not listed, but if the article type is the result of research, **then "Method"** must be listed.

DISCUSSION or RESULTS/FINDINGS (Capitalized, Bold, Tahoma 11pt)

The number of references is 20 references, 80% of published scientific journals and 20% of books. Plagiarism is 20% less by using Turnitin (Uploaded in the supporting file "Step 4. Uploading Supplementary Files" when Submitting). If this condition is not met, the editor will automatically mock the article.
