- Oversee all elements of the Sunday morning Kids experience
- Evaluate, plan, and manage a Kids Ministry budget (will be provided)

OTHER EXPECTATIONS

- Attend regular leader meetings at the One Hope Church Office (in-person or via video)
- Understand, update and communicate policies and procedures to parents and volunteers
- Oversee curriculum selection, development, and implementation
- Conduct regular training of volunteers at all levels (Nursery, Assistant Teacher, Lead Teacher)
- Communicate regularly with team members and parents about One Hope Kids
- Meet with Teaching & Discipleship Pastor regularly
- Make sure the Kids Team has all the resources it needs on Sundays
- Maintain a presence with the Kids Team and parents on Sunday mornings (be present on most Sundays; minimum of 40 per year)
- Recruit and train new volunteers
