Thank you for your interest in being a part of the Drumline at Cherokee Trail High School. The Drumline performs at many events throughout the year including sporting events, pep assemblies, and out in the community. The Drumline is a part of the CT Pep Band and a standalone performance ensemble. Drumline is not a class so all of the practices and performances are outside of the school day. Members of the drumline are committing to being a part of the ensemble at all rehearsals and performances for the 26-27 school year. Drumline is open to any student whether you are enrolled in a band class or not. It is not required that your primary instrument be percussion.

**Audition Materials:** Since there are limited spots available for the drumline, auditions for all spots are necessary. We will be accepting a total of 12 students. (3 Snare, 2 Quints, 5 Bass Drums, and 2 Cymbals). Please audition for the part you are most interested in. If you are not selected for your first choice of instruments, you might be offered a slot on one of your secondary instrument choices. You are welcome to audition on more than one part. If you are auditioning on the Bass Drum part, please play the entire rhythm, do not worry about split parts or different notes.
