

Chronology of Major Events on the Planet

- 70,000 yrs ago *Shell Mound people arrive in Néfa Basin and other places*
- 6000 *Shell Mounds near Anartu and Lilalara; 7 tribes, 3,000 people*
- 4500 *Sumis arrive on Lilalara, Eryan arrive at Gordha and Long Valley.
Sumis have with cuneiform clay tablets*
- 4000 *All major cities are established during 1000-year colonization
phase; a period of warfare begins. Mara/Ora and
Rafeli/Néfa compete for control of western shore*
- 3400 *Lilalara conquers western shore and Sumilara, sacks Gordha,
briefly conquers Long Valley, and dominates*
- 3200 *Iron Age (hot-forged iron) began by Eryan. Lilalara loses
Eryan-controlled areas*
- 3000 *Leaf paper and bark paper invented in Sumilara*
- 2350 *Lilalara overthrown, forced to submit to a western shore force and
grassland Eryan. Era of cavalry begins, dominated by
Gordha. Ora dominates the Sumi world until sacked by
Néfa.*
- 2200 *Sumilara builds a powerful navy and comes to dominate; with
Lilalara providing the army. Lilalara replaces clay with
bark paper 2000 years ago.*
- 1219 *Philosophical School of Mitrodato lasts 200 years*
- 1147 yrs ago (527 BW) *Reports about the Long Valley Eryan suffering from a
serious flood and on the move*
- 1146 *Long Valley Eryan migrate to Red River (Charda) Valley and
displace the Eryan there*
- 1144 *Rafeli (Néfa) falls to Eryan*
- 1143 *King Linamo of Mara (Ora) defeats the Red River Eryan and stops
their southward expanse, though Alnabu and Tamala (near
Belledha) fall*
- 1139 *Mara falls to the Eryan. The city had suffered severe economic
dislocation because the falling sea had left its port dry*
- 1135 *Namelo (city on the southwestern shore) falls to Eryan, who then
control the entire western and southern shores and half of
the northern shore. Sumis retreat to the eastern shore and
Sumilara Island.*
- 1087 *Ninurta/Naralon the Great reinvigorates the Sumi Alliance, drives
the Eryan from the north shore, briefly reconquers Néfa.
Founds the Great Library in Anartu.*
- 1021 *The year without summer; marks the beginning of the Great
Drought and displaces the Mountain Eryan (Tutanés)
westward against the Sumi eastern shore*
- 1017 *Moralana (Meddoakwés) falls to the Mountain Eryan*
- 1012 *The Eastern Sumi Alliance collapses as the drought destroys its
agriculture and the Great Fish Death destroys marine*

fishing. The Western Shore Eryan conquer Lilalara and Sumi cities on the northeast and southeast shore. War begins between the western shore and the Tutanēs.

- 980 *Records on Sumilara note the sacking of Néfa and Ora by the Tutanēs. Presumably, Belledha was previously sacked. Isurdhuna is repeatedly attacked. Dark Age descends on the world*
- 645 *Widumaj born in Isurdhuna*
- 620/(yr 1) *Widumaj has his “meteor dream” marking the beginning of His mission; reveals His first hymn*
- 583/37 *Mégékwēs comes to the throne in Ora and Néfa*
- 580/40 *Mégékwēs anointed King of the Eryan by Widumaj, whom he accepts as a Prophet of Esto. Initiates reform of Eryan law and army*
- 566/54 *Widumaj dies [I have not given the details of his life, as you have them already and the Sumilara records shed no additional light on them]*
- 563/57 *Mégékwēs conquers Meddoakwēs and thereby gains control over the entire settled part of the world. Tutanēs are later defeated several times and sue for peace, but rarely pay tribute*
- 544/76 *Mégékwēs dies*
- 281/339 *Eryan armies under Sumikēster I march across the shallow sea still surrounding Sumilara and conquer Anartu*
- 85/535 *Gésélékwēs Maj comes to throne and begins to reassert central control over Tripola, Belledha, and the Tutanēs*
- 61/559 *Gésélékwēs begins construction of the Royal Road and founds Kostekhéma to control Tutanē country*
- 55/565 *Gésélékwēs Maj dies and is succeeded by his son, Gesélékwēs Dwo*
- 26/594 *Gésélékwēs Dwo dies and is succeeded by his daughter, Dukterésto*

The attached paper offers considerably greater detail than this brief chronology. I am currently writing a book of several hundred pages in Sumi that will offer far more detail. If Esto wills, I will translate it into Eryan as well. I hope this paper can be read at the upcoming scholarly conference, so that all can benefit. Meanwhile, I am now quite sure this is the year 620 if one uses Widumaj’s Meteor Dream as the starting point of the calendar. For that reason I have used it in the date of this letter.

Volume 25 (Year 20/637-8)

- *Ekwanu of the Méménégone has appendicitis, almost dies; Méménégone have a pro-development “coup” as a result (March)
- *Morituora plans a museum and cleared archaeological site on mountain; new Lord tours Melwika museum with Thornton and asks for help (March)
- *Visit the Géndone; they have decided to enter the modern world (April?)
- *Plan to build the qiblih (May?)
- *Bishop Jonu resigns from Assembly because of health; Dr. Migélu is elected (May)
- *Mennea Tomu gets a new addition across Icehouse Road; Luktréstu becomes Vice President as Mennea Tomu is reorganized (May)
- *Médhpéla builds big temple to Endro (May)
- *Tiamaté has a baby (mid May)
- * Anara shell mound excavated in June; earlier population discovered. May, Jordan start at Lilalara to meet Marku and Skandu (June)
- * First veterinarianians complete uniyéri from Kwolone Géndha; learn more about the archaeology (June)
- *Fast economic growth causes problems; Melwika can’t make machines fast enough; they distribute the work to other places (especially those losing ice mining) (June)
- *Terskua gabrula building opens; laundromats start (June)
- *Rébu goes to Morituora (June) for summer génadema; Amos goes to Méménégone and Géndone to help with smelters (July).
- *Liz and Melitané ask the Kérékwes family for better washing machine prices; Thornton takes experimental pneumatic chainsaw to Sullendha (July)
- *Budhéstu plans to open a psychiatric section at Isurdhuna Hospital, asks Queen and Chris for money; washing machines in Frachvala, Melwika (mid August)
- *Plan for hydropower in Long Valley is pushed by Ora and is controversial; Mitranu of Mitranimela cheats the crown and must pay back the money; Amos asks Thornton about northern access route to Ghéslona (late August)
- *Mitranu is stripped of his powers as Lord; Town council appointed; Queen visits and announces the change and various development plans (early Sept.)
- *Power cable to Sumilara starts, mid Sept.; Plans for hydroelectric pipeline advance; New high school curriculum; controversial Sumi language bill finally passes City Council late Sept.)
- *Jordan and family and development consulting moves to Melwika; Jordan becomes CEO and embarks on an effort to add a spiritual concern to the Mennea Tomu’s priorities (Oct)

*Struggles with Luktréstu over maternity and paternity leave policies; more about washing machines; developments in Mitranimela; security company not doing so well (Nov.)

*Launch a Krésone génadema; Southern tribal assembly meets; Queen recognizes them as a province; they propose rebuilding the sacred spring (early Dec.)

Vol. 26 (Year 21/638-39):

* Twenty years!; Chris offers financial grants in Mitranimela and Dhudrakaita; Mitranu still defiant; Liz talks to Florané; (February)

* Vacuum cleaner designed; NOT given to Kérékwes family, but Khermdhuna; Rostamu and Migélu coordinate youth summer program; washing machines are now selling; Issue if Chris's giving away family money; Jordan points out this is now more complicated since he's not CEO; Luktréstu used to handle the details; more trouble with Luktréstu; hydroelectric plans finalized, wind turbines started in Sumilara and army is mad because Sumilara economy is booming anyway because of the reliable electricity; timber is now well managed on western shore and they have chain saws as well (March)

* Kérékwes family concerned they aren't getting the vacuum cleaner, want to know about the Investment Bank; Thornton in Moruagras overseeing plans for the canal and pipe; Pharmaceutical industry starts in Yimuaidha; two young women to dinner in Mennea house

* Chris and Amos go to Ghéslone to sign hydroelectric contract; Rostamu meets future wife; Yimuaidha contract finalized; plans for Investment Services discussed by family (mid April)

* Sértoba temple dedicated at National convention; Bilara temple delayed; Khermdhuna temple will be done next year; Qiblih design completed, will be finished in 2 or 3 years; Migélu elected National Spiritual Assembly secretary; numerical growth has slowed (early May)

* Luktréstu agrees to lead the investment consultancy; Chris meets Queen about economy and the group decides to create a Four Year Development Plan; Rostamu and Selané go to Gramdhunas; Jordan hires a female assistant (late May)

* Reorganize génadema; Launch investment consultancy (late June)

* Consultative Assembly meets to discuss Four Year Progress Plan; Lua goes to Sumilara to teach, Rostamu and Selané go as well (early July)

* Rostamu meets Prince Mégékwes; Consultative Assembly debates Progress Plan; Lords reject advancement of women as a priority (mid July)

* Rostamu and friends go to Kahingiru; Consultative Assembly approves progress plan; Queen announced a Royal Museum; North and East Tutane provinces announced (early Aug)

* Rostamu and Selané cooperate; Ninti wants to meet the team; the Queen wants Mégékwes to pull out but relents; the Queen and Werétrakester discuss opposition to the priorities (early Aug.)

* The team meets with Lord Lamuno and a Sumilara development plan emerges; Rostamu proposes to Selané; they tells Lua and she consents; Queen visits N Province Council (late Aug/early Sept.)

* Rostamu talks to Selané's parents and they give permission; Queen is in Wurontroba as well, talks to Chris and Liz about Mégékwes; Queen decides she needs Prime Minister (mid Sept.)

* Behruz and Rudhkrisu go to Moruagras to discuss gas and electricity; East Tutane province launched; dateline defined; northern road opened; Rostamu, Selané meet with Aisugu, Mégékwes, Jordanu in their new office to go through the grant requests; they agree to take Sumi with Mégékwes; Rostamu and Selané go to Gramdhunas to say goodbye to everyone there and invite them to the wedding; Chris, Jordan, Dëkané, Kandékwes, Kérékwes clan meet John, Yimu, talk about the new motor assembly line east of town (Brénménu, Sept/Oct.)

* Rostamu marries Selané; Royal Museum launched between Meddoakwés and Morituora; Fire almost burns down Terskua (Génménu/Nov.)

Vol. 27 (Year 22/639-40):

* Rostamu marries Selané; Royal Museum launched between Meddoakwés and Morituora; Fire almost burns down Terskua (Génménu/Nov.)

* Soru and family visit Terskua to see the mess; Chris and Liz stop by as well. Queen abolishes Lord Mitruluku's privileges and decides to establish a legal framework for councils

* Kandékwes and Mégékwes meet with Terskua Village Council; Moléstu argues with Ménu over construction schedule, meets with Chris and tells him of Terskua's reactions; Erduktér's play is performed and it's a hit; Queen asks Chris and Jordan for help with council structures; Mitruluku sends son Kandéstanu to Terskua to sell the northern half of the township to survive (Prusménu/Dec)

* Rostamu, Mégékwes talk to Kandéstanu; Dëkané goes to see Lord Albanu about contributing to Miller Motors' expansion; Refer to committee working on home rule documents; (Belménu/Jan)

* Lord Ornkordu asked Thornton to come to Moruagras to help with the election; Mégékwes and Aisugu go to Sumilara and have auto accident; Mégékwes and Skandé decide to go to Moruagras (mid Plowménu-late Eɟnaménu/Feb)

* Rostamu and Selané visit Wurontroba when beaver dam breaks; Mégékwes' article about Moruagras elections appears and he convinces parents to let him appear on Kekanu's radio show; Wurontroba's tractor is rescued from the flood, but people worry

about other breaking beaver dams; Mégékwes and Andranu invite Skandé to Pértatranisé.

* Mégékwes, Andranu, Skandé visit Pértatranisé and discuss journalism and Andranu's family with May and Amos; Thornton takes a geology trip across northern Terskua and to Lilalara where they learn about clay tablets with cuneiform; Rostamu suggests the junior youth study beavers

* Dékané goes to a cousin's engagement party, talks her former father in law into letting her go represent him to the Pérkas Council; Yimu sees the bikes and meets Amos; Dékané tells Chris and Jordan about becoming Manager of Pérkas; Selané and Rostamu's modular arrives in Wurontroba (mid-late June)

* The race begins with 7 entrants, including Jalalu; when the race reaches Sumilara on Day 4 Skandé meets Andranu's parents and Mégékwes visits his lover, encourages her to move to Melwika (early July)

* Amos is interviewed on the radio about hydropower and starts power generation as the racers arrive in Moruagras; Dékané visits Terskua but fails to get an agreement from the Council; she has supper with Yusdu and they discuss the future; the race ends and Dékané speaks to the Queen briefly at the reception for the racers.

* At the provincial development conference, Dékané recommends training for village councils and is asked to coordinate it; Chris laments it is hard for him to visit all the provincial tomus and Dékané suggests he invite Yusdu along

* The Miller Motors expansion is moving forward but the problem is equipment, not the space; Yimu is enjoying work and classes; Saré visits Melwika with brother and parents; Yusdu meets with Chris and Dékané at Chris's office to discuss the round the world trip; May attends a talk in Anartu about the cuneiform and bark books; Budhéstu invites her and Amos to dinner.

* Dékané ran a two-day conference for village councils in Belledha while Yusdu and Chris ran a development conference for businessmen and met with the tomu; Dékané and Yusdu head to an inn in the Polar Basin for the night.

* Rostamu and Selané return to Wurontroba to help with the destruction of the beaver dam south of the village; Yusdu is in town with Dékané and Chris suggests they get married; Prince throws a big beginning of semester lunch for his friends; Skandé and Andranu want to get married, but May and Amos say they should wait; Melwika Motors expansion is dedicated. (early-mid Génméné)
