Year Round

- Write 366 dictionary entries for conlang (I've spread them out)
- Write 366 short stories (I've spread them out)
- Read 150 books (I've spread them out)-- at least 5 books in French, at least 26 books in Romanian. Read Don Quijote in Spanish.
- Write Your World Challenge (read at http://wywamino.blogspot.com !)— 490-510 words a day about the world around me
- Weekly Series in a Year
- Stringing Words
- 52 Hard Truths Write one hard truth about yourself every week and share it with someone.
- 365 Hard Truths Write one hard truth about one of your characters a day... you can show the backlash if you want.

 - a. *The Three Musketeers, Madame Bovary* France (reading *Musketeers* in French, if I find *Madame Bovary* in French I'll read that too.)
 - b. Dostoevsky/ Asimov/ other Russian writers Russia (not sure which books yet. There's a lot, and I like them.)
 - c. Wuthering Heights, Agnes Grey, Shirley England (Brontë sisters rule.)
 - d. Romance of the Three Kingdoms, Journey to the West, The Confessions of Confucius China
 - e. The Ramayana, Kamasutra India

- f. Tale of Genji Japan
- g. The Odyssey, The Republic Ancient Greece
- h. The Epic of Gilgamesh Mesopotamia (we think)
- i. Adventures of Pinocchio Italy
- j. Don Quixote Spanish

Note: "Write a 50k novel" is the least important of all the challenges, since I already know I can do it. Novels may be spread out over a couple of months if necessary. It will be an exercise in PATIENCE.
