1. Costs due to Driver's Ed with Fred, LLC (Subject to change at the owner's discretion):

- A \$300 non-refundable deposit is due upon signing up.
- \$500 is due at orientation via PayPal, Cash, or Check.
- An additional \$25 fee will be applied for checks returned for non-sufficient funds.
- \$75 per session for any missed **class time**.
- \$50 per session for any missed **driving time**. This is applicable if there is no prior communication - at least 24 hours in advance.
 - Students are REQUIRED to make up any missed time.
 - You will need to schedule a date/time with Fred or Gina.

2. Additional cost, online AAA program:

- Member, \$39.95 (subject to change by them)
- Non-member, \$49.95 (subject to change by them)

3. 2-year permit from BMV:

- \$35.00 (BMV subject to change by them)

Class begins **Monday, June 1st in person from 5:00-6:30 or 7:00-8:30**. This is an orientation with a parent/guardian and the student driver. The parent/guardian is mandated to attend by the state. The orientation is split to compensate for the students and parents being in class simultaneously so please come during your assigned time. **Please bring a copy of the birth certificate and any prescribed lenses as there will be an eye exam.**

Tuesday, June 2nd, 5:00-8:00 pm **in person** with just the students.

Wednesday, June 3rd, 5:00-8:00 pm **in person** with just the students.

Monday, June 29th, 5:00-6:00 they return **in person** to take their permit test.

During the span between the third class and the permit test date, they will be participating in the AAA online program and doing their driving. It is a minimum of 28 hours, and they must do all the work. **They cannot attend the final test night if they have not completed the AAA course.** They **CAN** attend the permit test if they still have driving left.

If they have finished all their AAA, driving, and pass the permit test, they will receive a Course Completion Certificate that doubles as a 60-day temporary permit. **During the 60 days, they will need to apply for their 2-year permit at the BMV.**
