- **Marching Band and Music Appreciation** will be held during the Fall Term. Incoming freshmen should select these courses as their 7th and 8th course selections when signing up for classes.
- **Jazz Band** is held during the Spring Term. Only 3 total years of Jazz are represented here but 4 are possible with careful scheduling.
- ****Concert Band** is held before school hours and is not included in this sample schedule because it does not count against your 8 yearly course selections. Students should select Concert Band as a 9th class selection.
- This sample schedule meets or exceeds Graduation requirements and A-G requirements (see below).
- Students interested in **Winter Guard or Winter Percussion Teams** can see the Director of Bands once they start at Del Oro.
