 Woods know. We discussed possibly having a green screen for the pictures so
 photographer can superimpose the background for larger groups. Keith will also
 look into seeing if he can get any donations from some of our uniform sponsors.
 - Banners- We discussed the banners; where to move & which banners are
 expiring. For example, Cincy Kitchens has a 3 year deal ad this is the 2nd year
 for them. Soccer Fest banners are good for a year. Keith is looking into getting
 the program with more consistent begin and end dates. He is making a
 spreadsheet with sponsor information. Thinking will try to implement a renewal
 period where if you renew during a certain time period, the company gets a
 discount.
 - Side Effects- Keith talked to them and they are getting poles painted & will put up scoreboard for baseball in the spring. The basketball scoreboard is ready to go.

- BSN/Nike- Brad T is rep; They have other brands outside of Nike (Rawlings, etc...). Creates a loyalty incentive so everyone will buy through them. The Nike thing is just to get consistent look on uniforms. Can use as an online fundraiser. Winter coaches have already been in contact with Brad to create designs, etc...
 - Coaches' uniforms- Keith may need a couple of \$100 to pay for the embroidery. They get an allotment to outfit the coaches but embroidery is not covered. He will get back to us.

- Gary has a pepsi cooler we can use. Hot Dogs are put in the refrigerator straight from GFS. Maybe do not freeze the hamburgers either because they are difficult to cook when frozen. Deliveries are on Fridays so would be easy to leave out of freezer.
- Chris's nephew may be interested in doing a satellite drink station for his Eagle Scout project. We would love that!!
- VIP football parking spots- goes into football account. Football fundraiser. We
 had one person write a check and give it to us last home game.
- Team banquets- Keith asked where teams held their banquets. He will ask the coaches about their plans for this year. Money comes out of their booster account to pay for their banquet contribution.
