Timothy Mannix had a grocery store in Boston for several years before the family moved to Malone, Franklin Co. NY ~ Info from Elsie Hickey Wilson

Rossagh is located two and a half miles NNW of Doneraile Village. There are three townlands, Rossagh East, Rossagh West and Rossaghroe. "Rossagh" is Irish for "abounding in underwood". "Roe" is Irish for "red".

Notes on Rossagh East: In 1910 there were six houses Mrs. Mannix, farmer; John Kirwan, farmer; David Shea, farmer and Thomas Gallagher, farmer

Notes on Rossaghroe: Mr. Joseph Bolster holds the whole townland since 1850. In 1810 the occupants of Rossaghroe were James O'Brien, Edmund O'Connor, Edmund Mannix, James Mannix, Patrick Mannix, Timothy Leary and Marice Kirwan.

Notes on Ballyclough: Ballyclogh is about 5 miles north west of Mallow. The name is a corruption of "Ballycloughy", earlier called "Baile Cloiche". It means "The town or place of the stone" (castle). The Irish called a stone building simply "cloic" or stone. In Taxation of 1302 it was called "Lathban" and in the Taxation of 1306 it was called "Lachban". James Grove White notes that "lachban might be the Irish "Leach bhan" or "white rock".

Ballyclough has five townlands. Kilcranathan, Kilgoban, Kilmichael, Kilroe and Kilpatrick.
