**Position Overview:** Broadway for Arts Education (BAE) seeks enthusiastic and creative young people to assist in the production needs of our in-school and after-school programs for public **middle and high school** students in New York City for Part-Time, work-study positions. The **Junior Producers** will work with the program director and the executive director on producing digital content, live performances, assisting in fundraising, and other creative needs of the organization. We are looking for candidates who can begin in Fall 2025 to work a schedule that runs parallel to the New York City Public School academic calendar. BAE does not offer monetary compensation to Junior Producers, but they may gain school credit in accordance with their school's work-study program. Junior Producers are eligible for BAE scholarships.

- Speak multiple languages (ASL, Spanish, French, Creole, Chinese, Korean, Urdu, Bengali preferred)
- Candidates with a creative background in acting, music, performance, or visual arts

- Lead a fundraising campaign in the fall of 2024
- Junior Produce special events at WHEELS such as an Art Share in December 2024 and a musical in March 2025
- Junior Produce a fundraiser w/ the Broadway community
- Act as Junior Producers of the BAE-wide Art Share in the Spring of 2025
- Re-design presentation decks and impact reports for WHEELS (ongoing)
- Explore Grant writing and other funding avenues for their own artistic projects
- Participate in workshops with industry professionals
- Attend staff meetings as needed
- Maintain notes and thoughts related to all BAE work in a designated space (digital or physical)
- Regularly submit Storytelling assets for BAE social media and virtual presence
