## 11.4.6 Pedestrian priority on campus

## Description:

Pedestrians have the right to provide supporting facilities such as sidewalks, crossings and other facilities. Pedestrians have the right to have priority when crossing the road at intersections. If there is no crossing, pedestrians have the right to cross at the place of their choice while still paying attention to their safety. For this reason, the Vocational Education Program gives priority to pedestrians as an effort to provide protection, comfort and safety for pedestrians.

The pedestrian path policy at SMK has fulfilled several aspects, including:

- A. SMK provides pedestrian paths that meet safety aspects for road users
- B. Vocational activities provide pedestrian paths that provide comfort aspects (comfort) for road users
- C. SMK provides several sections of pedestrian paths which are equipped with disability-friendly facilities.
