Now it's time to present your research to share with the world!

Use a 48"x36" display board if possible. Your display board must include:

- Large, readable title
- Timeline of at least 8 events including birth (and death, if applies)
- Large photo or hand-drawn portrait of subject
- Information about:
  - o early life
  - o becoming famous
  - o accomplishments
  - o later years, if applies
  - o people in their lives
- 1 or 2 meaningful quotes from your subject
- Character traits with evidence. May be:
  - 1 important trait with at least 5 pieces of evidence
  - o 2 traits with at least 3 pieces of evidence each
- Photos with captions (at least two, more is better)

Be creative! Design your board in a way that makes sense for your subject.

Make it neat, colorful, and eye-catching. Take pride in your work! You do not need a header board, but you may include one if you desire.

In class, you'll prepare a short (30-45 seconds) speech explaining who "you" are and why you are famous. Include a quote from your subject. Practice your speech at home and memorize it.

At home, prepare a costume, possibly including props, to depict your subject. You may not hand out treats or tokens to your audience.

Have your speech memorized by Monday, June 10, 2024.

Bring in your display board by Wednesday, June 12, 2024.
