**Preparing for this meeting...**

**Reading:**

**Prayer:** Be praying that God would be sought more and more when it comes to reaching the lost. That our congregation would take seriously the call to pray for the people God has put in their lives. That praying with people who don't yet know him would be a regular part of what we do both on campus and off as a church.

**Meeting Focus and Learning Themes:** If anywhere, our churches as well as the lives of believers, should be places of prayer. Do we take seriously the call to pray for the lost? Is our church a place where prayer ascends on a regular basis? Do people in need know they will receive prayer when they come to our church?

**Opening Prayer**

- **Read:** Acts 2:42-47

- **Prayer Focus:** Pray that as a church we would be serious about prayer. Pray that the Lord of the Harvest would send the participants of our church out as workers in his harvest field more and more.

## Learning

**Teaching Theme: Read** John 17:20-21. If Jesus prays for the lost, so should we. “Prayer is the cornerstone of all effective outreach. We unleash heavenly power when we pray for lost people. We are also called to pray for ourselves and other believers to enter the harvest fields with God’s good news.” - Kevin Harney, *Organic Outreach for Ordinary People*

- What steps can you take to personally engage more in praying **for** those who are not yet in God’s family?
- What are some obstacles that keep us from praying? What can you do to remove them?
- How could you teach and train the people you lead at Shoreline to pray for and with the people in their life who are far from Jesus?
- How can you raise the engagement of praying for the lost in your area of ministry?:
- What are we doing presently that will help our church become a place of prayer? What are other steps we can take to increase our engagement in

prayer?
