MTSS (Multi Tiered system of support) Tiers 1,2, and 3

- 1- Curriculum- data from PSSA, MAP, Linkit testing. See if there are any specific issues or topics to focus on. During OP, kids work on IXL ½ hour during 5 day period. ½ ELA and ½ Math. This is all done during OP and class
- 2- Note specific kids who have gaps. Students who need specialized attention. Create subgroups in OP (keep them small). Pull kids out of express arts and work on comprehension with reading specialist or ELA teacher. Work targets specific students who need some extra work. This is fluid- kids can move in and out during OP as needed.
- 3- Students who have existing IEPs or those who need more support. Requires advanced tier team- permission to evaluate may be needed.
