3. Once I receive your completed questionnaire back, I'll be able to schedule your episode. Your voice message will kick off the show, (that's why I need you to use one of the templates provided) and I'll dedicate the entire episode to promoting your podcast and troubleshooting your issue.

### **But wait, there's more!**

If you implement my suggestions, I'd love to have you back on the show in 3-6 months to talk about how you've optimized your podcast. That means double the exposure for you!

Remember, if you have multiple questions, feel free to call back and submit each question using a template (you can use the same one that you used before or you can switch it up with a different one, your choice). The more, the merrier!
