

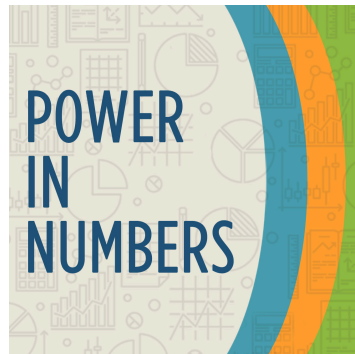

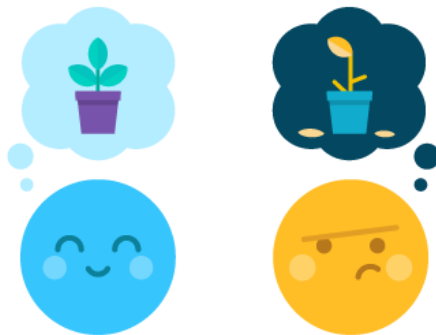

2. Where do you see math coming in handy in your own life?	

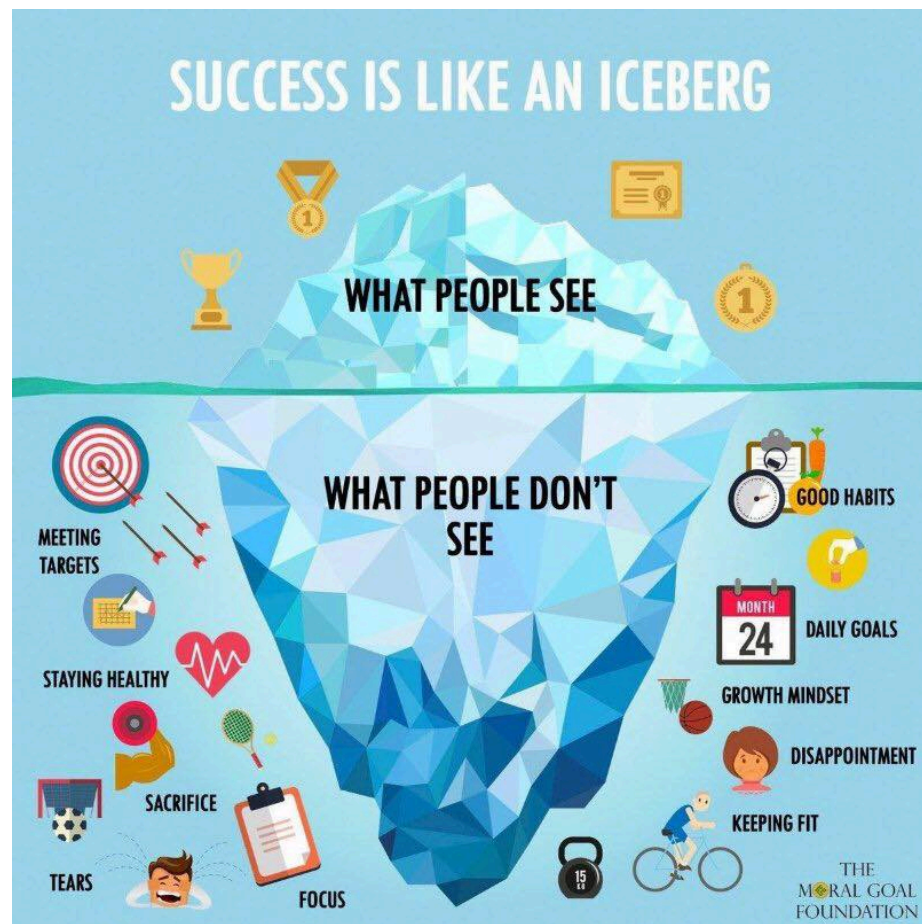
3. Have you ever said, "I hate math", or "I'm just not a math person?"
