Course Description:	Advanced Placement® is college-level coursework and exams that students can take in high school to receive college credit based on their scores. All motivated and academically-prepared high school students are able to enroll in AP® courses as long as the student has taken the recommended prerequisite courses.
Credit:	0.5 Credit per semester
	Students have the ability to earn college credit based on his/her AP exam score.
Grading:	Honors Courses Honor Course letter grades have the following GPA weights: A: 4.5 B: 3.5 C: 2.5 D: 1.5
	Advanced Placement® Courses Grades are weighted for each semester of Advanced Placement® (AP®) courses successfully completed with a grade of "C" or better as follows: A: 5.0 B: 4.0 C: 3.0 Grades below a "C" are not weighted.

Requirements:	 Attendance & participation is required Course materials AP Contract
AP Exams & Fee:	It is highly recommended that students sit for the AP® examinations in May. While exams are not mandatory at Epic, they will provide students the opportunity to gain college credit. Students may use their LF to pay for exams if fees are available. Exams are \$99 per exam. The late order fee/cancellation fee is \$40.
Enrollment:	Course request for Enrollment is available on the ILP. Deadline to enroll is September 15th, 2024 or until seats are full. Seats are limited/first come, first serve. The deadline to drop an AP® course is 14 days after initial enrollment. After 14 days, students cannot be changed from the course under any circumstances, even if they are failing the class.
